



Federal Investigation Of Cicero Riot Ordered

WASHINGTON — (A) — Attorney General McGrath said he is ordering a federal grand jury investigation of the July race disorders in Cleero, Ill., which developed when a Negro family tried to move into a white neighborhood.

Rioting involving an estimated 3,000 persons broke out and was brought under control only after the national guard was called out. The riots wrecked the apartment building involved so badly it is still unoccupied, McGrath was told.
