### Vast Air Power Expansion Slated, Sen. Lodge States

WASHINGTON — (P) — Senator Lodge (R-Mass) told the Senate that top military leaders of this nation have formally agreed upon a vast expansion of air power during the next three years.

during the next three years.

Lodge said the joint chiefs of staff "after prolonged and laborious discussion" have ordered a program "for expansion of the air force from 95 to 140 groups."

"The exact figure is a secret, but I believe this to be the general ratio," Lodge, a World War II array officer and long-time advocate of increased air power, told the Senate.

of the ground forces, Lodge said,
adding that would remedy "one
of our gravest weaknesses,"
"I understand this great increment of American strength will
be completed in 1954," Lodge said.
He said this means that of a

He said this means that of a recent congressional supplemental defense money bill of \$5,000,000,000 about two-thirds would be allocated to airforce expansion "and much of the rest of it will be completed in 1954."

Lodge said the joint chiefs, heads of the army, navy and air force, also "approved the activation of three more divisions for the U. S. army and one more marine division — all of which I have long believed were badly needed."


