## Jamboree Photos Saturday Night Will Win Awards

Awards for pictures of the grade school football jamboree will be given by a committee of the Kiwanis club of Roseburg, sponsors of the event scheduled for Saturday night on Finlay field in which the four grade schools will take part. Best pictures of football action, stunts by rooting sections, and comprehensive series will be selected by persons experienced in judging.

Subject matter of varied and unusual interest will be offered photographers, in picturing the antics of the youngsters in their effort to emulate the high school and college athletic extravaganza judged by persons experienced in this work, and will become the property of the club for use in newspapers, school organs, programs and in national publications having interest in material of such nature.

Should the photographers "cover" this event effectively, opportunity exists for publicity favorable to the community spirit of Roseburg. Situations doubtless will appear for the alert professional looking for parent-student cooperation in a community-wide program. Members of the publicity committee hope that material suitable for use in photo pages, rotogravure sections and "slick" magazines may be "shot" while the high school vendors, girls' rooting sections, and boys' teams are in action, and that sophisticated or news treatment may be emphasized for photographic themes, or human interest feature material.

### Merchants Cooperate

Cooperation from local merchants who advertise on the radio and in the newspaper in "plugging" the jamboree has been freely given, and the news media of Roseburg have volunteered their services in covering the activity. The committee wants all who take pictures to turn them in for judging, and believes there may be many surprise ideas suggested from full participation by those interested in photography. Pictures entered or donated should be sealed in envelopes bearing the contestant's name and delivered to Harold Hickerson at the chamber of commerce office, or Harry Hill's Shoe shop, or the Roseburg branch of the United States National bank. Present plans for grouping pictures include three classifications, action shots, rooters stunts and comprehensive series.

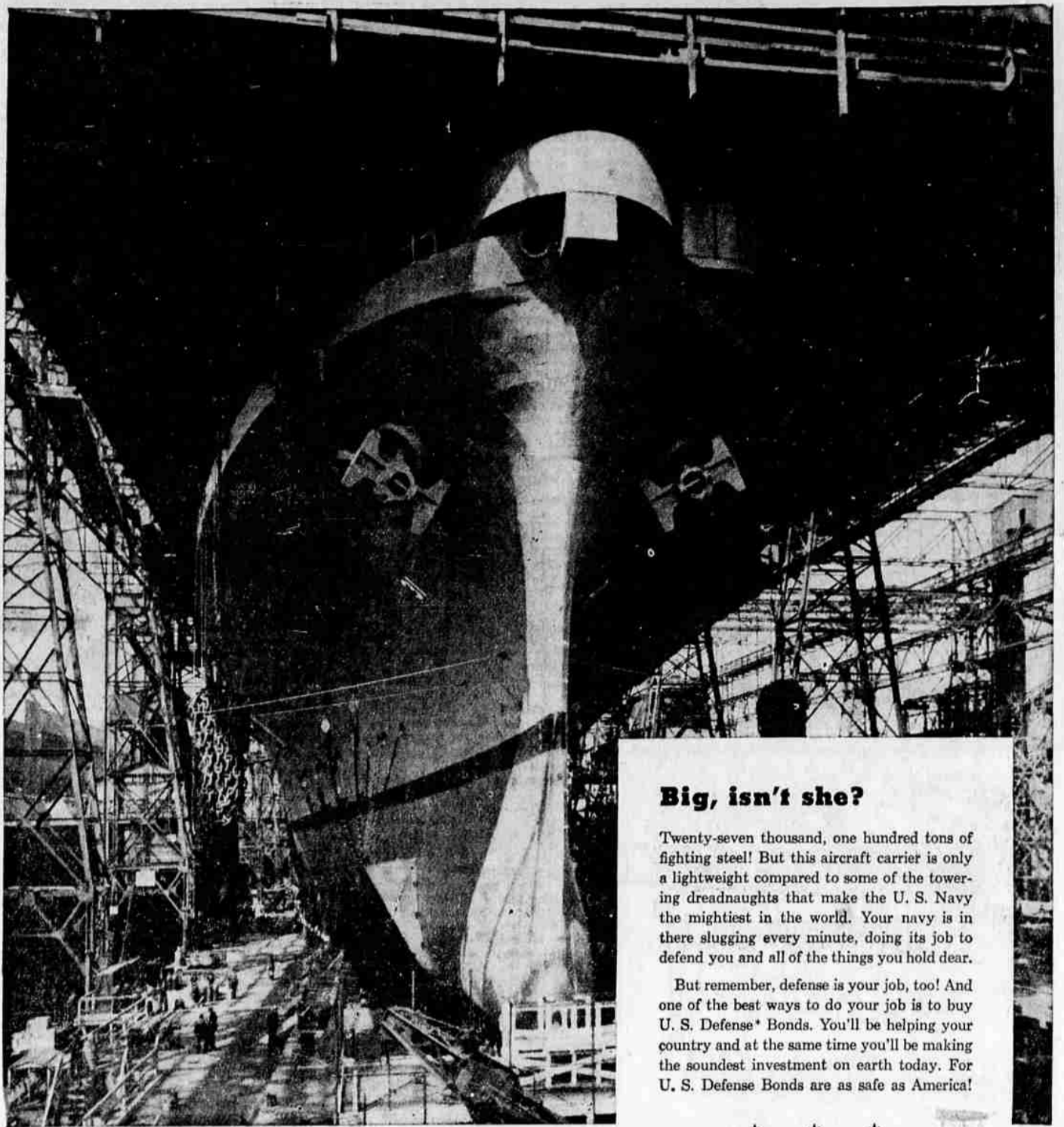
