**Vets' Requests For Training Will Be Reviewed**

WASHINGTON — (AP) — The Veterans administration says it will review all the applications which it has rejected from veterans of the Korean campaign who asked for vocational training.

VA said it wants to determine whether some 200 rejected veterans have since become eligible for training under a new law enacted Oct. 11. The agency added that the review will be automatic.

"Veterans whose requests had been turned down need not file new applications," VA said.

"Those who are eligible under the new law will be notified."

Before Oct. 11, vocational training for Korean veterans was limited to those whose disabilities resulted from combat, or from extra-hazardous service outside of combat.

Under the new law, a veteran may be eligible for training if he was disabled in service any time after June 27, 1950, and not necessarily in combat or under extra-hazardous conditions. Furthermore, the disability may have occurred anywhere in the world.
