Publisher Denies Attempt To Halt Taft Criticism

BOSTON — (AP) — The Boston Herald carried a statement by Robert B. Choate, its publisher, that he never attempted to suppress the opinions of his editor who resigned Sunday with a charge the paper refused to print his articles on Sen. Taft's book.

John H. Crider, Pulitzer prize-winning editorial writer, conceded he favored Eisenhower over Taft but said he had written what he thought was "a fair review of Taft's book with a comment or two of my own thoughts about the man."

The Herald also carried the disputed article by Crider and directly beneath it a review of Taft's book written for last Sunday's New York Times by Lindsay Rogers, professor of public law at Columbia university.

Sen. Taft's book is titled "Foreign Policy for Americans."

In the statement explaining his position, Choate said: "I have never attempted to suppress Mr. Crider's opinions, either as expressed in the newspaper or on television, where, of course, he was speaking on his own."

"On Monday Mr. Crider said that I suppressed a book review he

wrote about Senator Taft's 'A Foreign Policy for Americans'. The fact is that Mr. Crider expressed himself on the book in the lead editorial in the Herald on Wednesday. When I discovered that he intended to write, under his own name on the editorial page, an attack on Senator Taft under the guise of a book review, I called him up and told him that I thought it was ill advised and ill timed.

"Before I could explain my reasons, he said 'okay, okay,' and hung up. It was about an hour later when I got a call from a representative of the New York Times that he had told them of his resignation. While Mr. Crider was giving interviews to the press associations, he did not talk to me personally (about the resignation)."

Crider's article said "the major

opposition to Senator Robert A. Taft of Ohio springs from serious doubts as to his abilities and convictions in the field of foreign affairs."

Crider said also he "must profess general approval of his (Taft's) views on domestic matters, (but) it is with regret that this reviewer must confess to genuine fear of Taft blind spots in the international area."

The Crider article concludes with a statement that "senator Taft's book should be widely read, but it should be read discerningly. It is full of booby traps."
