## Senators Don't Reflect Voters' Views--Morse

PORTLAND — (B — Sen. Wayne Morse (R-Ore) doubts that the majority of Republican senators represents the thinking or the will of the majority of Republican vot-

Defending his voting record in a speech at the Portland chamber of commerce, Morse said he would not trade it for that of anyone he knows.

Morse criticized an editorial which appeared in the Oregon voting record on 20 issues and indicating that his voting opposed party thinking.

"I don't accept Charlie Sprague's (the paper's publisher) presumption that I voted against party unity," he said.

It was then he said that votes by Republican senators did not reflect the will of Republican voters. Morse branded his critics' talk of economy as "false economy." He said he was in favor of adopting the Hoover commission report for reorganization of the government. Some of his colleagues are not interested in having the report adopted in its entirety, he asserted.

About 30 percent of the report has been adopted, and if the rest of it were, the country would save between \$4,000,000,000 and \$7,000,000,000,000, he estimated.
