Briton Recalled On Czech Order

LONDON — (AP) — Britain called home today a British diplomat whom the Czechoslovak secret police fired upon last night during a purported "act of espionage" in a forbidden zone of Czechoslovakia.

Prague radio claimed that the diplomat, Robert Neil Gardner, and a British embassy typist, Miss Daphne G. Maines, were caught red-handed exchanging money for secret military information.

Miss Maines was shot and slightly wounded and Gardner was bruised in a cloak-and-dagger chase while trying to escape in a British embassy automobile, the Czechs said.

The foreign office said it had Czechoslovakia's assurance that leave the country as soon as she is discharged from a Prague hospital. She had been due for re-assignment, the foreign office reported.

Czechoslovakia handed the British embassy a note demanding that Gardner be recalled and quit the country before 6 p.m. Prague time tonight.

Egypt To Recall Her Ambassador To Great Britain

CAIRO, Egypt — (AP) — Most Cairo papers cried "bravo" today to Egypt's decision to recall her ambassador to Britain but a newspaper, which sometimes reflects the palace opinion, said bringing home the envoy does not mean a full break in diplomatic relations.

The French-language Journal D'Egypte urged harder efforts to solve the Anglo-Egyptian dispute and said "relations between the two countries will be maintained" even if the British also recall their ambassador from Cairo.

Withdrawal from London of the Egyptian ambassador "does not constitute an obstacle to future understanding and leaves the door open for future attempts at settlement," the Journal D'Egypte said. In the absence of the ambassadors, their embassies would be headed by the charges d'affaires.

But Akher Lahza, a paper which usually opposes the ruling Wafdist party, cracked:

"Thanks be to Allah, Churchill is still alive to see the successive blows being hurled at the crumbling British empire."

This was an apparent rejoinder to Prime Minister Churchill's wartime remark that he had not become head of the government "to preside over the liquidation of the British Empire."

Al Misri, outspoken pro-government paper, said "the government now has taken drastic measures to oppose British acts of aggression in the canal zone. These are very long range measures for it has been proved the British are very much annoyed by the government's decision to arm all Egyptians."
