For your Christmas entertaining, here are two delightful recipes.
The stuffed mushrooms can be
served as hot canapes before dinner and the parfait is light and

Stuffed Broiled Mushrooms

(Makes 4 servings)
Six-ounce can broiled mushroom crowns, 3-ounce can deviled ham, 14 teaspoon mustard, 12 teaspon grated onion, 12 teaspoon minced

Set aside. Mix egg yolk with about ¼ cup of the milk in saucepan. Add 2 or 3 tablespoons sugar, sail, tapioca and remaining milk. Place over medium heat.

Cook until mixture comes to a boil, stirring constantly—this takes 5 to 8 minutes. Pour small amount 114 cups cranberry sauce or cran

5 to 8 minutes. Pour small amount of hot tapioca mixture gradually on beaten egg white, blending well. Then quickly add the re-maining mixture, stirring constantly. (The hotter the tapioca and the faster it is blended in the thicker and fluffier the pudding will be). Add vanilla. Cool, stirring once after 15 or 20

minutes. Chill. Serve the tapioca cream and cranberry sauce layered in parfait glasses. (Make 5 layers, beginning with cranberry sauce). Top with the whipped cream.
