### Log Market in Oregon Getting Back to Normal

CORVALLIS — (AP) — The log market is getting back to normal in the Willamette valley, the Oregon State college extension service reported.  
The weekly report on farm forest products said the supply of logs increased in the past week with both sawmills and loggers adjusting to price control orders.  
Logs sold at ceiling prices—\$37.50 a thousand board feet for No. 3 second-growth logs in the Lane-Douglas area and \$42.50 for No. 2's delivered to mills. In the Columbia river district, second-growth logs were \$40 for No. 3's and \$50 for No. 2's.  
Other forest products were unchanged.
