SALEM — (AP) — General Eisenhower isn't a candidate for president yet. But Oregon's delegations to both Republican and Democratic national conventions might have to vote for him.

While 1952 will be an off-year for state politics because no governor or United States Senator is to be elected, the presidential primary should provide a show for the whole country.
Never before has the same man been entered in both parties in an Oregon presidential primary. The candidate himself never has anything to say about whether his name is to be entered.

Truman vs. Eisenhower?
In the Democratic race, it looks like President Truman and General Eisenhower will be the only candidates. The President hasn't said whether he would run again, but leaders of the state's Democratic organization are ready to file his name.

1948 Race Recalled

They campaigned like candidates for sheriff, as if the entire national election depended on it. Dewey won that primary and went on to get the nomination.

U. S. Fliers Need
Better Aircraft
To Smash Reds
FIFTH AIR FORCE BASE, Korea (AP) — A flying colonel whose "boys" have shot down 139 Communist planes said Thursday American jet pilots "need more and better planes" to keep up with the growing Red air force over Korea.
"The enemy has a better airplane and far more than we have," said Col. Harrison R. Thynge, his Fourth Fighter Interceptor Wing flies Sabre Jets, fastest U. S. plane in combat.

New Sub-Machine Gun
Shoots Around Corners
DETROIT (AP) — The Army has perfected a sub-machine gun that shoots around corners.
And what is more, Joseph C. Soma, project engineer at the Detroit Arsenal, says the curved barrel is more accurate than a straight one.
Sights are secret, but the gun shoots a .45 calibre slug that can be deflected as much as 90 degrees and will pierce an inch-thick pine board at 100 yards. It will fire 450 rounds a minute.
The around-the-corner gun is made by attaching a curved barrel to the army's M3 sub-machine gun, commonly known among GIs as the "grease gun."
