### Richard Gordon Slater Signs For Marine Corps

### Cpl. K. Hanna Serving With 7th Infantry

Cpl. Kenneth K. Hanna, 211 W. Washington, Roseburg is serving with the 7th Infantry Division on the Korean front. A veteran unit of the Korean fighting, the division recently has been engaged in patrol activity along the snowy east-central front.

### Peach Leaf Curl Control Now Due

Peach leaf curl, one of the most serious diseases of peach in Douglas County, can be effectively controlled by use of several spray materials if properly and thoroughly applied during January, according to J. Roland Parker, county agent. Spraying can be done anytime when the weather is dry. Sprays dry within an hour or so after application but should not be applied when weather is foggy or while raining or the trees wet.

Standard sprays for peach leaf curl are Bordeaux 12-12-100 or three pounds of Febam to 100 gallons of water. Both are recommended for home use or commercial orchards. For the owner of two or three trees, Puritized Agricultural Spray is recommended, using three liquid ounces in five gallons of water. Small quantities of spray material is easier to make using the Puritized Agricultural Spray although somewhat more expensive per gallon than sprays recommended for commercial orchards.

### Control Board Okays T-B Hospital Project

SALEM (AP) — The State Board of Control approved preliminary plans Tuesday for the \$719,000 building project at the state tuberculosis hospital in Salem. The plans call for a two story addition to the present hospital building, with 60 more beds; and for an employees dormitory for 48 persons.

The board also approved a one-week's course, to be given here starting July 21, for employees of the state schools for boys and girls. The course will be given by Don D. Cramer, chief of the division of training and treatment of the California youth authority.

### VAGRANT JAILED

Albert Allen Culbertson, 22, Eugene, was given a 10-day jail sentence Tuesday after pleading guilty to a vagrancy charge, before District Judge A. J. Geddes. Culbertson was arrested by State Police.

### Jack Dempsey Looks For Boxing Talent

He announced Tuesday night that he hopes to arrange a series of tournaments throughout the nation. He invited amateurs, 18 or older and weighing more than 175, to sign up. The bouts would be three rounds each, and 10-ounce gloves would be used. There would be no entry fee.
