Hardboard Plant Project Started At Grants Pass

GRANTS PASS (AP) — Local businessmen, buttressed by a favorable survey report, will go ahead with plans for a hardboard factory whose initial cost will be about \$900,000.

At a meeting Monday night, the group sponsored by the Chamber of Commerce, heard Carl Chapman of Chapman Forest Utilization Corp., Corvallis, report on the amount of waste wood products available in this area and the likelihood of a successful operation in converting the waste into boards. His verdict was favorable.

The meeting authorized Charles R. Cooley, chairman, and members of the board to seek federal approval for sale of \$500,000 in common stock, \$250,000 in 8 percent debentures, and to try for a \$300,000 Reconstruction Finance Corporation loan.

The tentative plans of the group, formed as Rogue Hardboard Inc., call for a 300 by 180-foot main plant, with a smaller warehouse and office. Capacity would be 60,000 feet per 24 hours.

Infant Found Unhurt 17 Hours After Abduction

NEW ULM, Minn. (AP) — An 18-day old baby boy was found unhurt here Friday, 17 hours after he was kidnapped from his home in Mankato, 28 miles southwest of here.

A short time after he was found, the infant was restored to his mother, Mrs. Eugene Callahan, who was called here from her Mankato home.

Chief of Police Edward L. Larson said Mrs. Leonard Scheid, a childless woman in her middle 30's, had admitted taking the baby to replace one she lost four months ago through miscarriage.

The baby was found in Mrs. Scheid's apartment over a tavern in downtown New Ulm.

Mrs. Scheid, a woman of about 35, sought to police and newsmen that she had recently given a barroom acquaintance some \$300 to "buy" an illegitimate child. When the acquaintance failed to produce the child, the woman drove to nearby Mankato with a gun and took the baby boy, according to Chief of Police Ed Larson of New Ulm.

Metschan Promoted By U. S. National Bank

Phil L. Metschan, formerly manager of the Roseburg Branch of the U. S. National Bank of Portland, has been promoted to the position of vice-president of the institution. He has been an assistant vice-president since leaving Roseburg.
