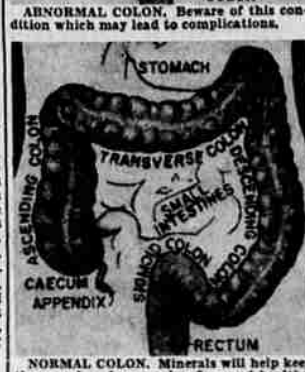

Oregon Colleges Show Enrollment Decline

PORTLAND (AP)—A drop in enrollment of 12.4 per cent at state colleges was reported Monday by the state board of higher education.

That is a normal drop for the winter term, officials said. They listed the total enrollment at 11,938—Oregon State 4,645, Oregon 4,085, Oregon College of Education 450, Southern Oregon 561, Eastern Oregon 432, Vanport 908, Dental School 306 and Medical School 55. College course changes, including three at Oregon State, were approved by the board. The University of Oregon protested saying the changes encroached on major fields until now reserved for the University.

Douglas Fir Tops All Species Of Wood In Variety Of Service To Man's Needs
How long will durable Douglas fir timber withstand insects and disease once it's been killed by fire or natural causes?
Douglas fir trees killed in the Yacolt fire of 1902 are still sound. Evidence continues to mount, according to W. D. Hagenstein, chief forester for the Douglas fir industry, of the tremendous resistance to natural enemies—fungi and disease—which nature has developed in this great tree.
Hagenstein says no other American timber species serves human needs in such a wide variety of ways as does Douglas fir. It is the leading softwood veneer and plywood species. It provides about one-fourth of all the lumber sawed in the nation. It supplies raw material for about a million tons of wood pulp each year. In addition, its long, straight trunks are used throughout the world for poles and piling.
Durable Douglas fir lumber is most familiar as framing for houses, schools, factories, churches, and other necessary structures for human use, the forester observed.

Vital Secrets Slip From Army Signal Corps
WASHINGTON (AP)—At least eight investigating groups are reported looking into complaints that vital secrets may be seeping out of the Army Signal Corps Intelligence agency.
This agency collects reports of fact and rumor from various U.S. agents around the world.
The inquiry was set off by complaints from 10 of the agency's employees, including three Army officers, Rep. Cox (D-Ga.) told the House Monday. The agency employs 90 civilian and 21 military personnel.
Cox said one of the three Army officers, Lt. Col. Ollie J. Allen, was transferred to California only last month and had expressed the fear this was done to silence him. Allen recorded his observations and requested an investigation, the congressman said.
The Chicago Tribune reported Saturday night that the ten Signal Corps employees had requested the inquiry. And the newspaper said the inquiry had uncovered there was no record of 57 "top secret" documents. It quoted Army Intelligence officers as saying a check had accounted for all except 11 of the documents.
