Union's Hiring Ban Knocked Out By Court Ruling

SAN FRANCISCO (AP)—Declaring that no qualified person should be denied employment through the union's hiring system, Federal Judge Dal M. Lemmon Wednesday formally enjoined the Marine Cooks and Stewards Union from engaging in discriminatory hiring hall practices.

The judge also warned two steamship companies—Matson Navigation Co. and American President Lines—that refusing to hire workers discriminated against by the union constituted an unfair labor practice.

The injunction followed an opinion and preliminary injunction passed down in November.

Unfair labor practice charges against the union and the company were brought by the National Labor Relations Board on behalf of seven stewards. They said they had been ousted for supporting a rival union.

MCS became involved in other legal troubles Wednesday when 95 former union members filed suit in Marin County Superior Court seeking \$245,000 awarded them against the union last year in King County, Wash. The suit said they had been unable to collect.

The original suit also charged the union blacklisted the men and deprived them of jobs for supporting a rival union.
