Woman Facing Abortion Charge Hit By Tax Lien

PORTLAND — The federal government Wednesday put a tax lien for more than a million dollars against Ruth Barnett, a naturopath who is under grand jury indictment on a charge of manslaughter by abortion.

At the same time it filed a \$406,604 lien against Beatrice Cook of the same downtown office building address, 801 Broadway Building.

The lien against Dr. Barnett brought under her married name of Ruth Barnett Bush—lists these sums in additional income taxes sought:

\$340,541 for 1945; \$315,149 for 1946; and \$507,563 for 1947.

The filing says these are additional sums owed. It does not say how much was paid for those years.

The Beatrice Cook listing is: \$203,316 for 1945; \$194,304 for 1946; and \$8,983 for 1947.

Although her address was listed as the same as that for Dr. Barnett, the Internal Revenue Office reported she was believed to be living at Jennings Lodge, and to have had no connection in recent years with the Broadway Building address.

Arleigh A. Burke Gets Nomination

WASHINGTON — Arleigh H. "31-Knot" Burke, a central figure in the Army-Navy unification controversy, was nominated for a permanent appointment as rear admiral Monday.

President Truman's nomination of Burke and 11 others for appointment as rear admiral of the line went to the Senate. So did the President's nomination of Daniel W. Ryan as rear admiral in the Dental Corps.

The 50-year old Burke, a brilliant officer in World War Two, had been passed over previously when the roster of nominations for permanent appointment to the flag rank was made.

But, Truman did raise him from the rank of captain to the temporary rate of rear admiral in December, 1949.
