#### Dentists Sans Reserve Status To Be Drafted

**PORTLAND** — Six Oregon dentists will be drafted into the Army as enlisted men unless they apply for reserve commissions before their induction date.

That was the announcement Wednesday of Oregon Selective Service officials who said earlier that they would begin drafting doctors and dentists soon to meet Oregon quotas.

Col. Francis W. Mason said draft notices were being sent to the six dentists. They will be inducted April 22 if found acceptable. Enlisted men may apply for commissions after being inducted, but Mason said whether the applications would be granted "rests entirely with the armed forces."

### Congress Given Blame For Bad U.S. Conditions

**PORTLAND** — Congress and not the President should get the blame for "extravagance and corruption" of the New Deal and the Fair Deal, Frank Jenkins, publisher of the Klamath Falls Herald and News and a life-long Republican, said here Tuesday.

Addressing 500 Dairy Co-Operative Association members, Jenkins said that "Congress is the keeper of the purse" and it could at any time since 1932 have asserted its authority and "stopped the spending dead in its tracks."

That means Jenkins said, "We've got to pay as much attention to hiring a congressman as employing a hired man."

On morality in government, he said the people set the tone. People walk past illegal slot machines, he said, and do nothing about it yet open display of the devices means someone is getting a payoff.

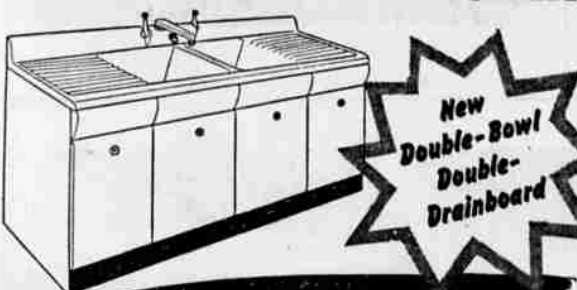

### Christian Film Dated At Church

"A Wonderful Life," a 45-minute Christian film, will be shown at the North Roseburg Church Sunday evening at 7:30.

Sponsored by the Evangelical United Brethren Denomination, in cooperation with the Religious Film Association, this stewardship film dramatically portrays the true greatness of a very common man who died nearly penniless because he spent his lifetime helping others.

His college-age daughter was stunned and embittered at her father's death, feeling that his generosity had caused unnecessary sacrifice for the family, but discovered that the entire community was deeply grateful for his "wonderful life."

The film, highly recommended by denominational leaders, presents moral arguments against the loss of faith in face of tragic personal loss.

Humor and deeply spiritual drama are combined in a real life story of a Christian family living out their faith.

The film, along with the Rev. Clark Robb's sermonette, "I Do All That's Expected of Me," is part of the March Sunday evening series on typical answers to the question: Are you a Christian?
