**WASHINGTON** — The first of the administration's new appropriation bills was through the House Tuesday with budget-cutters boasting a minor victory. They imposed a 2 per cent cut in two of the President's budget requests. Passed by voice vote late Monday and sent to the Senate, the bill would appropriate \$3,488,668,000 to finance the Treasury and Post Office Departments for the fiscal year starting July 1.
