It will do no good to say that Jesus was a good man and nothing more. Jesus was called God or He wasn't good.

It was as the God-Man that Christ, by His substitutionary death upon the cross, was able to reconcile heaven and earth and to win salvation for every man. That is why John writes near the end of his Gospel:  
"These things are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that, believing, ye might have life through His name."
