

## Mock Warfare Now On Biggest In U.S. Annals

FORT HOOD, Tex. (AP) — Operation Long Horn, biggest maneuver in U.S. military history, came off the planning board at one minute after midnight when two brigades of the 82nd Airborne Division stormed across the Lampasas River.

The 82nd, aggressor force in this giant mock war, threw a Sunday punch at the U.S. force, the 47th Infantry Division, on the front, the 31st Infantry in the rear and the First Armored in reserve.

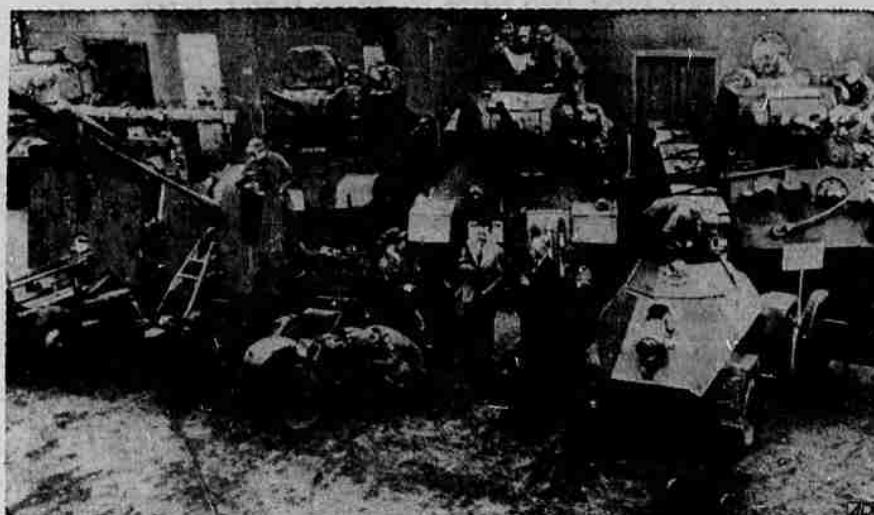
Until one minute after midnight this was strictly a paper operation, but when the cocky parachute infantrymen hit the lazy Lampasas, you couldn't tell it from the real thing.

In theory, the "aggressors" have made their way in sledgehammer fashion from landings on the Gulf of Mexico. They engulfed the southern portion of the U.S. and in Texas now hold a line generally from here in Central Texas to Bryan to the Gulf.

Across this gigantic military reservation and leased ranchland, the theory of ground-air warfare at its zenith will be explored. New weapons will be tried, including simulated atomic artillery.

The maneuver will cover 1,800 square miles with 115 to 120,000 men taking part. Besides the divisions, the 17th Armored Cavalry group with two tank battalions is attached to the aggressors.

The British Commonwealth is sponsoring a six-year plan for the development of South and Southeast Asia. Known as the Colombo Plan, it is expected to benefit 570 million people at an estimated cost of more than \$5 billion.

### Job Training Still Available To Disabled Vets

Vocational rehabilitation training is still available to veterans who were disabled during World War II, in spite of the fact that most veterans no longer can begin training under the G.I. Bill, it has been announced by the Veterans Administration.

According to the VA, two entirely different laws are involved, and some disabled veterans have believed that the termination of their benefits under the G.I. Bill also terminated their rights to vocational rehabilitation.

Rehabilitation training for disabled veterans, the VA said, is provided for under Public Law 16, the Vocational Rehabilitation Act, which is still available. The only requirement is that training must be completed by July 25, 1956. This would permit the beginning of a two-year school course, for example, as late as July, 1954.

However, any disabled veteran requiring 48 months of training should make application to the VA immediately, in order to start training before July, 1952.

The Servicemen's Readjustment Act, the so-called G. I. Bill, expired for most World War II veterans on July 25, 1951, which was the final cut-off date for starting training for all veterans discharged before July 25, 1947.

The VA said any World War II veteran, or Korean veteran, with a service-connected disability, is entitled to apply to the VA for training, and he will be allowed to enroll if it is determined that he is in need of vocational rehabilitation and is otherwise eligible.

Korean veterans, the VA pointed out, need not actually have served in Korea, so long as their service on active duty has been since June 27, 1950.

Disabled veterans of either World War II or the Korean campaign can apply for rehabilitation training at any VA office.

### Front-Yard Hoosgow Gets Few Occupants

MIDWAY, Ala. (AP) — You'll look a long time before finding another hoosgow like the Midway jail.

It's on wheels, sits in a Negro woman's front yard and puts its occupants up for public inspection.

Midway folks find it satisfactory, though. Very few of them ever get locked up.

The jail, which resembles an animal cage more than it does a lock-up, is a discarded convict wagon. Since any passerby can see who's in it, the inmates usually are subject to quite a bit of ridicule from persons on the outside.

No claims have been made about the jail being even remotely escape-proof. Not so long ago, eight persons got thrown in it to sit something of a tenancy record. Seven promptly ripped out the floor and escaped. The eighth was too fat. He got stuck and couldn't get out.

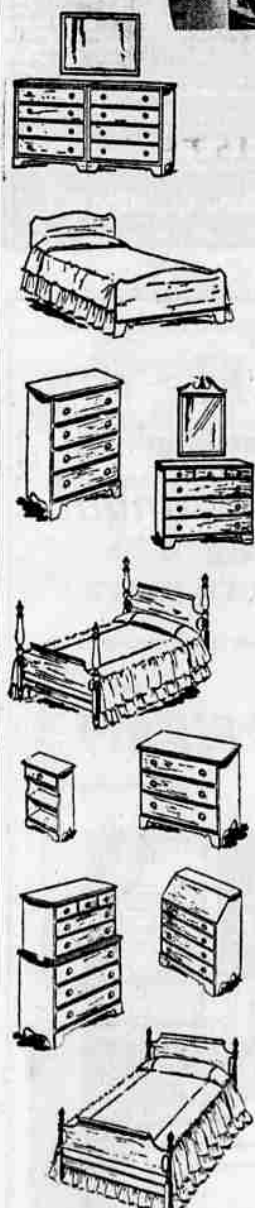
