

First Service At New Lutheran Church Dated

The first service conducted in the new Faith Lutheran Church at 330 First Street will be that of Holy Communion on Thursday evening, April 10, at 8 p.m. The service will be in commemoration of the Last Supper of Christ with His disciples on the evening before His crucifixion.

On Easter Sunday, the new building will be used for the first time for Sunday morning worship. Two services are being planned, at 8:30 and 11:00 a.m. The church school is also planning a special Easter service to be presented at 9:45 a.m., entitled, "Remembering Jesus Christ."

The theme for the Holy Thursday Service will be "But By Being

Bought," the last in the series of special Lenten services under the theme, "The Way of Denial." The sermon theme for Easter Sunday will be "The Surge of New Life."

FBI May Assist Senators' Quiz On McGranery

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Senate Judiciary Committee decided Monday to hold hearings on President Truman's nomination of James P. McGranery to be attorney general.

No date for the hearings was set. Even before the formal decision to hold them, some senators predicted privately it might be weeks before the Senate acted.

McGranery must receive senate approval before he can take the cabinet post.

Sen. Watkins R-Utah, one of the committee's 13 members, said in advance he wants a full and complete investigation that may involve long questioning of McGranery, now a federal judge in Philadelphia and a former House member and top Justice Department official.

"It's our obligation to check and examine his qualifications," Watkins said, "particularly his connections with the notorious Amerasia case."

FBI Check Requested

Chairman McCarran, one of those who predicted confirmation may be delayed, already has asked to see a "full FBI check" on McGranery that has been brought up to date.

Although FBI reports on government officials and employees normally are denied congressional committees, an exception has been made for the Senate Judiciary Committee chairman.

For years, he alone has been able to examine FBI reports on judges, U.S. attorneys, marshals and the attorneys general appointed by the President.

Britons Explode Nazi Bomb Asleep 12 Years

LONDON (AP) — A 500-pound German bomb which awakened from a 12 year sleep in the east end was blown up by the Royal Engineers at dawn Wednesday. Windows cracked and houses in the neighborhood were shaken.

The bomb was found eight feet underground by diggers on a building site Tuesday. Its time fuse began ticking and an SOS went out for the bomb disposal squad. Air raid wardens recalled that seven bombs had fallen in the neighborhood during a Luftwaffe attack in 1940 and only six had been accounted for.

Good Prices Expected For 1952 Potato Crops

REDMOND (AP) — Good prices can be expected for the 1952 potato crop, Al E. Mercker, Washington, D. C., told growers here.

Mercker, head of the Agriculture Department's Fruit and Vegetable Division, said promotion and advertising programs would increase potato consumption.

In the Northwest to address a series of district grower meetings, Mercker said Oregon growers should "learn to work with Maine growers" in raising promotion funds to sell potatoes.

He said the potato acreage this year probably would increase only about 3 per cent but would go up substantially in 1953.

Oregon Men's Statues' Placements Sought
