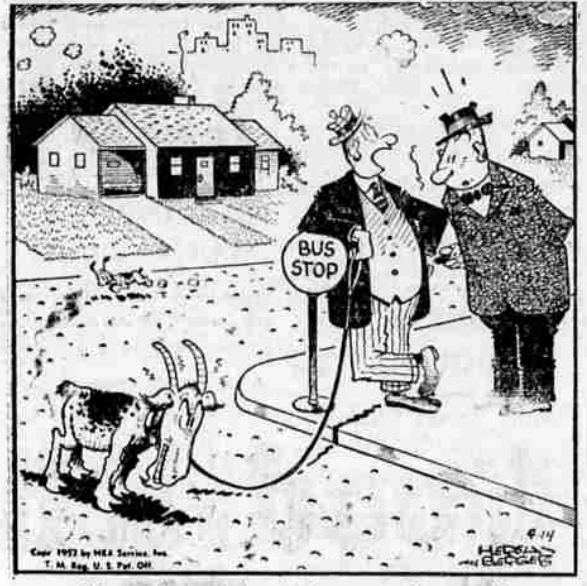

Cougars And Ducks Score Victories In Track Meets

The Washington State College Cougars, showing the strength that won them the 1951 Northern Division, Pacific Coast Conference, track championship, opened defense of their title Saturday with a 93-37 1/2 win over Idaho's Vandals.

In other meets, the Oregon Webfoots, tabbed as one of the division's stronger teams, edged Washington 63-61 1/2 at Eugene, and Oregon State outpointed Portland University and Lewis and Clark at Portland.

WSC took 11 firsts, one first place tie and swept the shotput and javelin events in the Cougar-Vandal meet at Moscow. Eric Roberts won the high jump (6 feet 2 inches) and the broad jump (21 feet 10 1/2 inches) and led WSC scoring with 10 points.

Dave Martindale of Idaho was second with 9 1/2 points.
