Ban On Jap Land Owners Kayoed
SAN FRANCISCO (AP)—A 32-year-old California law aimed at preventing Japanese from owning land was ruled unconstitutional Thursday by a 4-3 vote of the state supreme court. But the court balked at basing its decision on the United Nations charter. Instead the court said the law had, in effect, been rendered invalid by decisions of the U. S. supreme court. The law had been the basis for seizure of Japanese operated farms after Pearl Harbor. A state district court of appeal had held in 1950 that the law was unconstitutional because it violated provisions of the U.N. charter outlawing discrimination against resident aliens. Chief Justice Phil S. Gibson, speaking for the majority, said the U.N. charter cannot supersede federal or state laws. He added: "The U.N. charter was not a treaty obligation but 'amounts to a promise of future action on the part of member nations.'"

OMAHA, Neb. (AP)—The mad Missouri threw its worst at Omaha and Council Bluffs Friday with an army of workers still winning the battle to hold the great river in its strait - jacket of dikes. The river crest - stretch of maximum of water flow - was so long and so subject to fluctuations that it couldn't be pinpointed but river forecasters said the rampaging river is at cresting stage and will continue to crest all day. The next 48 hours may determine whether the tremendous water pressures will burst through levees and cause more agony and damage along this river which has become a monster of destruction.
