Chairman Named For Boy Scout Fund Campaign

Charles Thomas, Douglas District Boy Scout finance chairman announced that the following men will head up the finance campaign in the various communities of the district outside of Roseburg. They are "Speed" Holmes, Drain; Fred Booth, Yoncalla; J. E. Sifers, Oakland; Bill Bolman, Sutherlin; Paul Hult, Dillard; Bob Wheeler, Camas Valley; George Acker, Tiller; Lyman Worth, Riddle, and Mr. Croucher, Myrtle Creek.

The kickoff for the campaign in these respective towns will take place between May 5 and 10. The chairmen are now recruiting team captains, who in turn will recruit five workers on the fund raising campaign, attempting to raise their part of the Oregon Trail Council budget, which will total \$90,000 for 1953, said Thomas.

Roseburg will not take part in the county campaign, as the Scout committee here has agreed to join the United Efforts Chest, which is now in the process of being organized. Irv Pugh, who is heading up the organization individual campaigns, provided that all agencies cooperate. The response has been good thus far, but considerable details remain to be worked out, said Pugh.

Three-Way Campaign
Thomas, in reference to the Scout campaign, said there are three ways in which the Boy Scout organization raises money, all different and separate from the other. No. 1—Each boy or adult member pays a registration fee, which is sent to the New York headquarters to finance the national organization.

No. 2—Each local troop is responsible for earning its own money to purchase personal emblems, Boys Life Magazine, camping gear, food for camp, or any other troop expenses needed to carry on the individual troop's activities.

No. 3—The local council fund raising campaign. All its money is raised from individual contributions, independent drives, Community Chests throughout the area. The money goes for paying overhead expenses, such as keeping records, maintenance of summer camp, hiring a staff, paying for awards given at various activities put on by the council and training. None of the money goes to individual boys or units, but comes back to them indirectly through their use of the program and taking advantage of council training courses, activities and council conducted Scout camps.

Thomas also stressed that the budget for 1953, and for past years is not established or set by the professional staff, but by the local scouts throughout the whole council area.

"This is our council and we should be proud of the accomplishments we, as scouts, have attained the last few years," he said.
