CO-OPERATION!

FROM THE RECORD—

The Sheriff's Office co-operates fully with the State Police, returns all prisoners for the State Police from other counties and states. Also takes all prisoners to the Oregon State Pen.

The Sheriff's Office co-operates fully with the City Police in all the cities of the county, returns all prisoners for the City Police from other counties and states, and furnishes aid and assistance on call.

The Sheriff's Office co-operates fully with the County Civil Defense Organization. Sheriff Carter is the County Deputy Director for Civil Defense. The County Defense radio net is maintained and operated by the Sheriff's Office to insure 100% readiness in case of emergency. The Civil Defense Office has been set up and is maintained in the Sheriff's Office to insure complete readiness for emergency and to save the Tax Payer extra money! An emergency boat, motor, and trailer has been procured and is maintained by the Sheriff's Office for immediate readiness for rescue or other emergency purpose.

The State Police and the City of Roseburg use the County radio station on Mt. Nebo to insure radio communication in emergency, and to provide complete cooperation.

ECONOMY!

FROM THE RECORD—

It cost over \$26,000 to run the Sheriff's Office in 1943, and in spite of the increase in costs and devaluation of the dollar it only cost \$116,000 to run it in 1951! The criminal department of the Sheriff's Office has grown from one office deputy, one criminal deputy, and one part-time criminal deputy to a force of two office deputies, six criminal, and one civil deputy during that period. Population more than doubled, taxes increased almost four times—with all the additional work and effort required to maintain the clean record of the county and to keep the county a place where you want to live and where you want your children to grow up!

RESULTS!

FROM THE RECORD—

Population of Douglas County in 1943 was approximately 26,000. In 1952 it has grown to more than 55,000.

FROM THE RECORD—

The Sheriff's Office processed 401 prisoners in 1943 and 883 prisoners in 1951 for a total of 9261 prisoner days in the county jail. Prisoners transported to the State Pen in 1943--22; in 1951--46.

Cost of prisoners' meals was 50c per meal to the county in 1943--and is the same today! But in 1943 the prisoners were fed meals from local restaurants which were cold and unpalatable by the time they were served. Now they are fed hot, wholesome, palatable meals prepared and served immediately from the jail kitchen. Last year over 21,000 meals were served to prisoners in the county jail.

The prisoners do their own laundry. The jail has been expanded and modernized, and now is rated second highest in the state by the Bureau of Prison Inspectors. It is one of seven jails in the state of Oregon that U. S. Marshals are allowed to use for holding prisoners while in transit!

The tax department collected almost \$1,000,000 in 1943; in 1951 almost \$3,400,000. A modern machine system has been installed so that the work is handled without additional steady employees, and even less part-time help is employed during the busy periods. One tax deputy is employed full-time for the collection of delinquent taxes.
