

Gen. Wedemeyer Heads Pro-Taft Committee

WASHINGTON (AP)—Lt. Gen. Albert C. Wedemeyer Monday assumed the chairmanship of a national Taft-For-President committee and promptly announced that Taft's candidacy is supported by Gen. MacArthur.

Wedemeyer, who retired after a long military career, said he took the committee assignment on the urging of "numerous prominent Americans including Gen. MacArthur."

He told a news conference MacArthur called him a week ago to urge him to head the committee "for the good of the country."

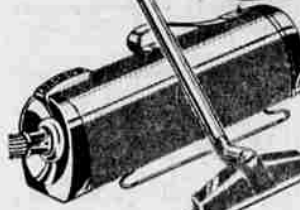
"This is quite a clear indication that he is supporting Sen. Taft," Wedemeyer said.
