**'Coon-On-A-Log' Contest Arouses Humane Society**

MEMPHIS (AP) — Howls and shrieks from hounds, humans and raccoons echoed over Lake Miguel and brought the Memphis Humane Society up in arms. The uproar Sunday came from a "coon-on-a-log" contest—a controversial sport which the society versus sport which the society calls vicious and inhumane. George R. Bates, humane president, said he would seek a court injunction to prevent any similar competitions in the future. The contest was for the "southern championship." Forty hounds were entered. About 500 spectators attended. It works like this: The coon, with a handler nearby holding a tether, is placed on a log floating about 50 feet from the bank. The eager hound is sent to drag him off. If the swimming dog succeeds in

getting a grip on the spitting, scratching coon, the tangle is broken up by the handler, who pulls the coon out of danger by the tether.
