Stojack Back For Bout With Jack Lipscomb

Popular Frankie Stojack is back at the Roseburg wrestling pavilion again this week on the same card as Leo Wallick, but again they fail to meet.

The muscular Tacoma airplane spinning artist meets Jack Lipscomb in the hour-long semi-final. Stojack still feels he got a "raw decision" two weeks ago when Referee Buck Weaver awarded a match to Leo Wallick after the Detroit mauler had used Stojack's trunks illegally for leverage. He got even with Weaver last week when he put him out in the second fall with an airplane spin.

Now he's championing at the bit for a rematch with Wallick. He has already protested to the Roseburg Wrestling Commission and says he'll put in another protest unless the Commission acts promptly. The rematch fell through this week when Wallick coyly sidestepped by saying he didn't think Stojack deserved a return match.

Meanwhile, Stojack is liable to have his hands full when he meets Eugene's veteran Jack Lipscomb. Lipscomb is in fine shape, is heavier, and is out to post an upset in order to move back into the top ranks of wrestling heavyweights.

The main event has all the elements of blood and thunder. Leo Wallick and Buck Weaver were the only two who would agree to sign for an hour match with Japan's foremost judo stars, Masa Kimura and Shibusu Yamaguchi. It will be a combination judo and catch-as-catch-can tag team match.

Hollywood's Johnny Lindell put on a control show Thursday night as he blanked Seattle 1-0 on four hits. In the other games San Diego beat Oakland 5-3 while Portland dropped San Francisco 4-2 and Sacramento beat Los Angeles by the same score in 10 innings.

The Stars could pull within half a game of San Diego Friday night but they need two wins coupled with a Padre loss to do it. They won Thursday night in the ninth inning when Chuck Stevens rapped out a 370-foot triple and scored on Jack Phillips' sharp single to left field. That gave Lindell the victory over Al Wilmar who had allowed Hollywood only five hits.

Red Adams won his second game of the season for Portland as he tossed the Beavers to the win over San Francisco, ending a five-game losing string for Portland and a four-game winning streak for the Seals.

Two unearned runs in the sixth gave Portland the game. Del Bisatti erred in handling Jo Brovia's high infield fly with the batter reaching second. Eric Tipton was tossed out but Eddie Basinski reached base on an error by Len Ratto. Brovia and Basinski scored on an outfield fly by Herm Reich and a squeeze-play single by Adams.

Fishing Fair As Coastal Streams Become Clear

The Roseburg office of the Fish and Game Commission reports fishing is fair in coastal streams, which are becoming low and clear. Bait and wobblers are best for use.

Rogue River salmon fishing is good, and improving from Savage Rapids to Galice. Trout fishing in the main Rogue, Applegate and Illinois rivers and in their small tributaries is favorable. Best catches are made with worms and flies.

Trout angling is poor in the upper Umpqua area, because of high and turbid water conditions. Better catches are made on spinners and bait. Salmon fishing is slow throughout the river.
