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'Forever Amber' Author Given Big Tax Refund

WASHINGTON — The U. S. Court of Claims said Tuesday Kathleen Windsor is not a writer.
On that basis, the court awarded her a \$26,588.72 refund on taxes paid on the sale of motion picture rights to her best-selling novel "Forever Amber."
Judge Evan Howell, who wrote the unanimous decision, held that Miss Windsor wrote primarily for her own amusement. Although she has written since childhood, he noted she has published only two books.
The court agreed with Miss Windsor's attorneys that the \$165,000 net proceeds from the sale of picture rights should have been taxed at a lower rate as capital gains rather than as ordinary income.

ODELL HONORED

PORTLAND — Morgan S. Odell, president of Lewis and Clark College for the past 10 years, was honored at a testimonial banquet here Monday night.
Speakers included Edgar W. Smith, president of the State Board of Higher Education, and Gov. Douglas McKay.
The college had one building and 135 students when Odell became president in 1942. Today it has a campus with 21 buildings and an enrollment of 1,120.

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POW Riots Due To Outside Urge, Gen. Clark Says

KOJE ISLAND, Korea — Gen. Mark Clark said Monday that "without question" the bloody riots and other disturbances by Red prisoners of war on Kojima were directed by Communist truce delegates at Panmunjom.
The United Nations Far East commander asserted that the Red truce delegates "directed the uprisings here and the disobedience of" camp commander orders.
"They care nothing for the lives of these prisoners here, so they are willing to direct them to do all kinds of things that will embarrass and have embarrassed us," Clark told a news conference.
He conceded the U. N. has no positive proof there is a direct connection between Kojima and Panmunjom. He apparently meant that no radio messages, letters or agents between Kojima and Panmunjom had been discovered.
But Clark said:
"There are so many instances where the Communist world knew of events taking place here, and reflected them at Panmunjom and so many instances where events at Panmunjom have been reflected here, that the implications are obvious."

Taunts Bring Death

Clark arrived for his first visit to Kojima only a few hours after tank-supported American infantrymen moved into two POW compounds and ripped down Red flags and banners. A half hour after he flew back to Pusan, a South Korean officer shot and wounded a prisoner who was taunting the officer.

Clark said "the maximum amount of force will be used to make rebellious Red POWs obey orders."
"If these prisoners of war, who have flagrantly violated all of the instructions, or many of the instructions, for so long, continue to persist, why then the maximum amount of force will be applied to make them conform to the legitimate instructions of the camp commander."

Clark did not estimate when the U. N. would "obtain uncontested control" of the POW compounds, which hold 80,000 men. But he said it would be "as soon as possible."

War On 'Hoppers Eating Barley Crop Readied

KALAMATH FALLS — Preparations were underway to attack an invasion of grasshoppers which have caused thousands of dollars worth of damage to the valuable barley crop south of here.
Some 25,000 acres of valuable matting barley in the Tulelake area of northern California were surrounded by the grasshoppers.
Federal prisoners from a Tulelake work camp were given the job of mixing poison mash to be spread by plane in an attempt to kill the horde. Sam Smith, Federal grasshopper control specialist, is in charge of the fight.

Two CARE Agencies End Relief Services

NEW YORK — Two of the largest member agencies in CARE have withdrawn from the private relief cooperative which has helped Americans aid thousands of needy foreigners in the past six years.
The two agencies, one Catholic and the other Protestant, say they are withdrawing because they believe the need has passed for the work originally done by CARE.
"General relief can now be handled more efficiently through regular organization channels," the

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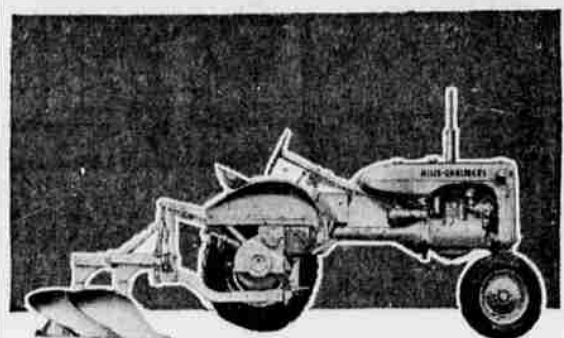
