## OSC Will Play Duke In Opener

OMAHA — It was "batter up" Thursday in college baseball's biggest show.

Eight teams, the cream of nation's collegiate diamonds, are after the NCAA title in the sixth annual college World Series being played for the third straight year in Omaha's million-dollar Municipal Stadium.

The field this year is perhaps the best so far.

Thursday's four games saw all eight teams in action but eliminated none. Only the twice-beaten will be side-lined in the double

elimination play. Favorites to become the new kings of the college baseball are the heavy hitters from Duke University, winners in 30 of 35 games they played this year.

Duke was paired with Oregon State in the second athletic meeting in history between the two schools. The first was the 1942 Rose Bowl football game, won, incidentally by an underdog Oregon State team.

Texas, twice winner of the NCAA title, is back again and paired with Penn State in first day's play.

## Churchill Tells Britons Crisis

LONDON — Prime Minister Churchill told Britons Wednesday they are keeping their heads above water in the fight for economic survival but they will have to "swim against the stream" in order to win.

Speaking at the annual meeting of the British Press Association, the 77-year-old Conservative leader called on Britain to face up to an economic crisis "scarcely less vital" than the London bombings of World War II.

He referred to this country's persistent excess of spending over

earnings in international trade and the serious drain on its gold and dollar reserves. He added:

"Thanks to the unpopular measures that have already been taken by the chancellor of the exchequer, we have reached in the last six months a position of equipoise.

"Our head is above water, but it is not enough to float. We have to swim. We have to swim successfully and we have to swim against the stream."

He said his speech was "more than an alert — it is an alarm."

## LaMotta Given Decision Over Murphy In Wild-Slugging Bout

DETROIT — Jake LaMotta, the human sledge hammer who improves with age, will fight anyone "if there's enough cabbage in it." And anyone includes light-heavyweight champion Joe Maxim or challengers Sugar Ray Robinson and Randy Turpin.

Jake thinks his unanimous decision over Irish Bob Murphy Wednesday night in one of Detroit's wildest-swinging, most-rousing 10-round fights proved he could campaign as a light heavyweight. Jake

is a former middleweight champion but has forsaken the lighter class.

No matter who Jake fights, they love the squat little 169 pound Italian here in Detroit. A near sell-out crowd of 16,008 exploded to its toes when Jake, behind on points until then, battered Murphy with savage rights and lefts to win the ninth and tenth rounds and the decision. Murphy had a 6 1/4 pound advantage.

For eight rounds the two slugers traded block-busters. Jake, finally solved the ex-sailor's left-handed style and pounded two lefts to his face at two minutes of the ninth round.

Jake continued the windmill attack and won the edge from the officials.

## Mrs. Rogers Hornsby Files Suit For Divorce

ST. LOUIS — Mrs. Rogers Hornsby filed suit in Circuit Court here Wednesday for separate maintenance from the deposed manager of the St. Louis Browns.

Married in 1924, Mrs. Hornsby said in her petition that 56-year-old Hornsby, one of the all-time baseball greats, abandoned her in 1945. She charged his refusal to pay her a "reasonable" monthly allowance was intended to force her to sue for divorce. She brought a divorce action in 1934 but dropped it.

In requesting a court order for her support, Mrs. Hornsby said the Rajah, as he is known in baseball, had a large income as a result of his connection with the Browns.
