Portland, Sacramento Divide Twin Bill

Beavers Trip Solons, 3-0; Lose 3-1 Tilt

Portland and Sacramento split a Pacific Coast League baseball doubleheader Thursday night while San Diego Padres made it two-in-a-row over Seattle.

The Solons required two extra innings to take the opener at Portland 3-1. The Beavers won the nightcap 3-0. Each game went nine innings.

In the ninth inning of the opener, Solon Vinnie Smith doubled in Ritchie Myers, who had singled, and Jor Gordon, who had walked; those were the winning runs.

In the afterpiece, Joe Brovia singled in Frank Austin, and Don Egert homered for the two Portland counters. There was good pitching on both sides. Lyman Linde gave up three hits and struck out 10 Sacramento batters. Solon hurler Ken Gables yielded only four blows.

San Diego reliever Theolic Smith won his second game in two nights against Seattle. He held the Rainiers to two hits in 6-1-3 innings as the Padres rolled to a 7-4 triumph and a 2-1 series edge.

Smith, who pitched hitless ball for the single frame he worked Wednesday night, took over in the third Thursday night from waverling Jack Salvesson.

The Rainiers collected one run in the second and three in the third, all off Salvesson. The Padres spaced their counters, getting one in the second and two each in the third, fifth and final innings.

Third place Oakland made it three in a row over Tom Heath's San Francisco Seals, 3-0, advancing within 4 1/2 games of front-running Hollywood. The loss left the Seals sharing the basement with Sacramento.

The game was played under protest after the eighth. Heath claimed Tookie Gilbert slid illegally into second sacker Jim Moran, preventing a double play.

In another neighborly scrap, Hollywood dumped Los Angeles, 6-1.

Standard Time Petition Nears Signature Goal

PORTLAND — The Oregon State Grange reported Thursday that it lacks only about 2,000 of the necessary signatures to put a mandatory standard time measure on the November election ballot.

Grange officials said they had 23,315 signatures. The additional names must be filed by July 3.

Heats were deemed necessary in the 100 and 800-meter running events and the 400-meter hurdles, followed by finals in these races and the 5,000-meter run.

Field events on the opening schedule were the javelin and hammer throws, the shot put and the broad jump.

World Freedom Will Be Upheld, Gen. Clark Says

TOKYO — Gen. Mark Clark said Friday it is impossible to predict what will happen in Korea, but he is "confident the security of the free world will be upheld."

"We have asserted unmistakably to the Communists that we are prepared to stake flesh and treasure on stopping aggression," the United Nations commander said.

"We harass them 24 hours each day to weaken their aggressive power and to show them that we continue to mean business."

Clark departed from his prepared address to the Japan - American Society to say the bombing of North Korean hydroelectric plants was "a military decision only" and represented "no change of policy."

The Allies, he said, have pushed the Communists "out of territory which they coveted to have convenient bases for pressure against Japan."

The Reds have been offered reasonable peace terms, Clark said.

but they have replied with "injective, falsehoods and bombast" which they "seem to think conceal their reluctance to join in the peace they so shrilly claim to be cherished by themselves alone."

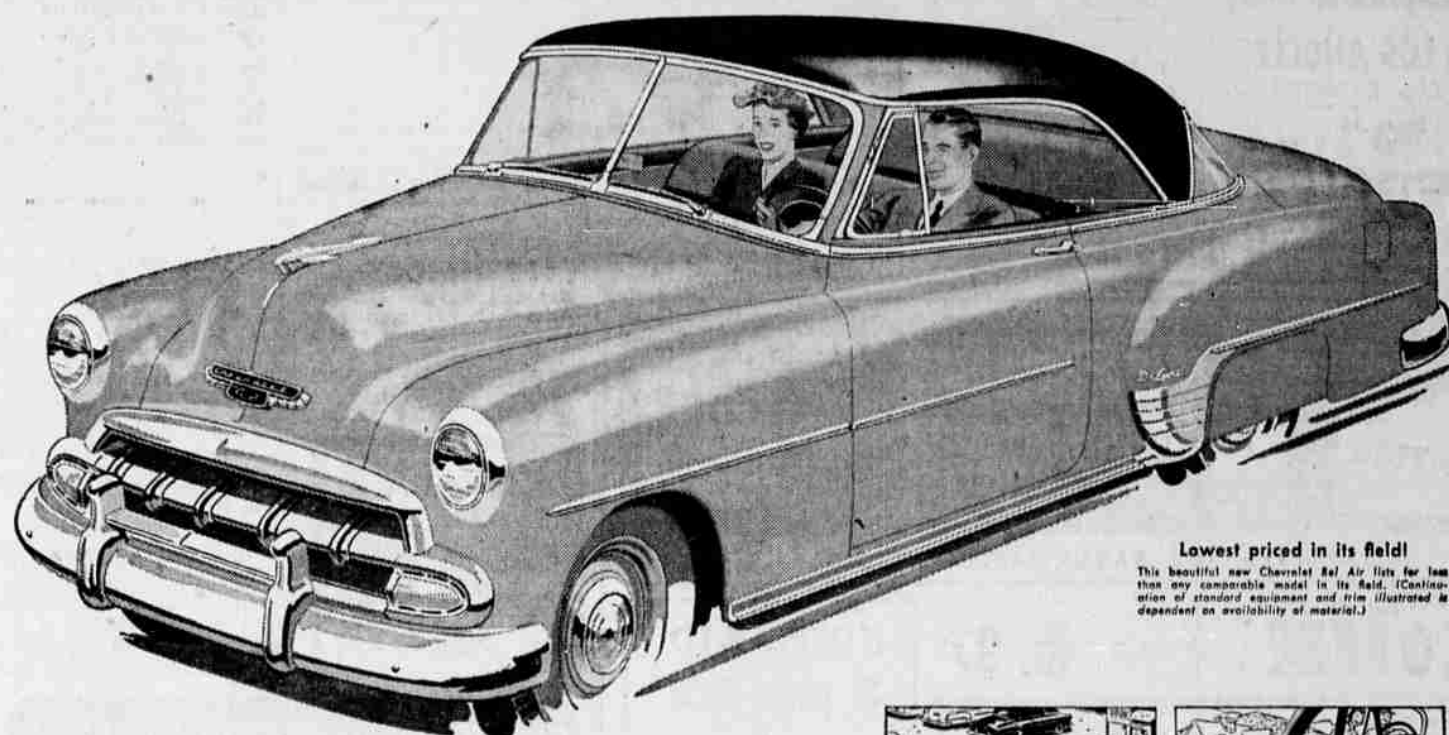
