Country Needs Truman Policy, Harriman Says

TACOMA — Averell Harriman, making a bid for Washington's 22 votes at the Democratic national convention, said Tuesday night a continuation of President Truman's policies will bring this country strength and security.

The touring Democratic presidential aspirant made it clear to a capacity crowd of 600 at a Pierce County Jefferson-Jackson Day dinner that he aligns himself completely with Mr. Truman's domestic and foreign programs.

Harriman, the nation's mutual security director, said his party has a "phony majority in Congress of men masquerading as Democrats." He called for their ouster, along with Republicans opposed to the "Fair Deal" program.

He had a kind word for Dwight D. Eisenhower as a soldier but said when the five-star general embraced the Republican party "he became one of them." Harriman later referred scathingly to Republicans as "grim old pessimists."

In an appeal for a big Democratic turnout at the polls, Harriman also told his audience that "those who say Senator Taft will be easy to beat don't understand
