Construction Work

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Contracts Slated On Highway Work In Douglas County

The State Highway Commission, meeting in Portland Thursday and today opened bids and considered awarding contracts for 27 highway bridge, traffic signal and building construction projects aggregating \$8,000,000, the largest amount involved in any one contract letting in the commission's history. Approximately \$6 million of the total is for bond financed projects.

The 27 projects call for 46 miles of grading, 14 miles of rock base and surfacing, 51 miles of oiling and 28 miles of black top paving, 10 bridges totaling 3,820 feet in length and the construction of one shop building.

The commission receive bids on 5 projects in Douglas County, the largest of these projects involves the grading of the Anlauf-Elkhead Road unit of the Divide-Rice Hill section of the Pacific Highway. This is the second unit of a major highway relocation project between Divide and Rice Hill and lies about four miles easterly of the existing Pacific Highway.

Plans call for grading of sufficient width to provide for future three-lane construction to provide a passing lane on steep grades, four-lane construction over the summit about 1 1/2 miles south of Anlauf and for 1 1/2 miles south therefrom and two-lane width on southerly to the south end of the project. The design also calls for the construction of frontage roads for local traffic with access provided at controlled points and complete separation of traffic at county road crossings. A temporary rock surfacing is to be placed on a portion of the project to provide a travelway at points of conflict with existing county roads.

Bridge Projects Included
A bridge contract covering two structures within the limits of the previously contracted Divide-Anlauf unit of the Divide-Rice Hill section of the Pacific Highway is to be let whereby one structure is to carry existing Pacific Highway traffic over the new relocated highway about 700 feet southerly of the present Comstock overcrossing, and the other structure is to provide access under the highway for traffic to a sawmill.

Another bridge contract in Douglas County calls for the constructing a new bridge 332 feet in length over Calapooia Creek on a line change within the limits of the previously constructed Calapooia Creek-Sutherland section of the Elkton-Sutherland Secondary Highway northwest from Sutherland.

A grading and paving contract on the middle unit, Reedsport-Dean Creek section of the Umpqua Highway running east from Reedsport will provide a 2-lane oil mat wearing surface and three foot shoulders with an extra lane for ascending grades with improved line and grade as compared to the existing narrow roadbed. No roadbed excavation or embankment work, which will remove or cover existing pavements is to be performed on this section until the early part of 1953 as the existing pavement is to remain in place and be used by the traveling public through the winter months of 1952-53. Completion of the project is set for Sept. 30, 1953.

Another contract in Douglas County calls for the regrading and paving of portions of city streets in Riddle and Glendale. In Riddle, Front Street is to be improved from a point about 400 feet east of Pine Street easterly 0.34 mile to the east city limits, to provide a three-inch thickness of 20-foot asphaltic concrete pavement. Glendale, Pacific Avenue between 3rd and 5th Streets is to be similarly paved but to a width of 30 feet, and 3rd Street between Pacific Avenue and the railroad to a width of 20 feet, each with 10-foot rock shoulders alongside the new pavement. These improvements are to be financed with State funds allocated to city street improvements.
