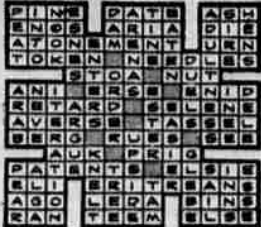

Attorney Beaten By China Reds

HONG KONG — Robert T. Bryan, an American attorney, said Saturday the Chinese Communists beat him with a rubber hose and used spinal drug injections to wring statements from him during 16 months imprisonment.

Bryan, 59, a China resident for 45 years, was deported from China June 28. He refused to talk to newsmen of his experiences until he boarded the liner President

Cleveland bound for San Francisco.

He said the Reds tortured him to confess but "most of the time I never could figure out what they wanted me to confess."

Light In Sky Beacon's Reflection, Theory

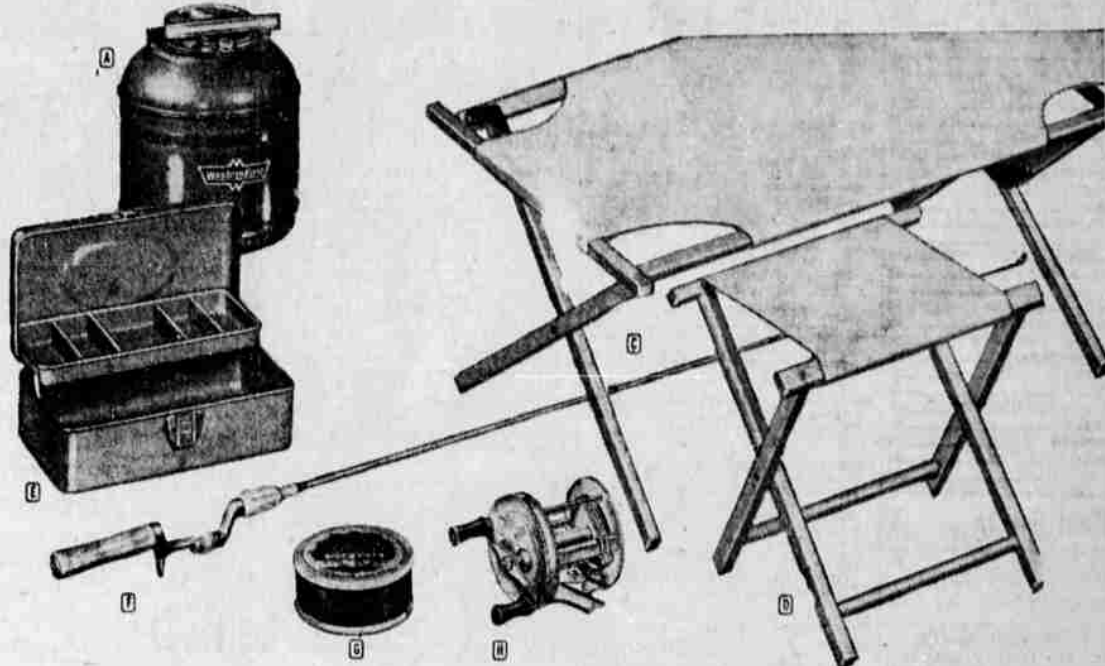
