Petitions Aim To Save Wilsons From Gallows

PORTLAND — Petitions were circulated here Tuesday, asking Gov. Arthur B. Lange of Washington to commute to life in prison the death sentences of Utah and Turman Wilson.

The Camas, Wash., brothers are under sentence to hang at the Washington state prison, Walla Walla, Aug. 15 in the kidnap-slaying of JoAnn Dewey at Vancouver more than two years ago.

The petitions are sponsored by the Committee for the Commutation Brothers' Sentence, headed by the Rev. Allen C. Lambert, pastor of the Hoyt Street Methodist Church here.

The Rev. Mr. Lambert said the number of petitions to be circulated would be decided at a meeting Thursday night.

The petition said that many persons had expressed belief in the innocence of the brothers and "to execute men while there is any doubt as to their guilt is a violation of the most fundamental human rights and a crime against society."

Execution of the brothers has been postponed three times previously.

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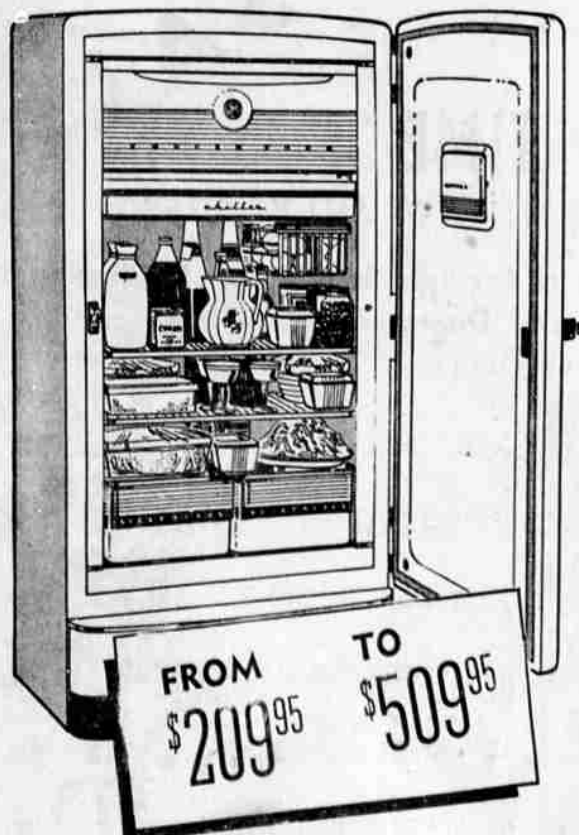
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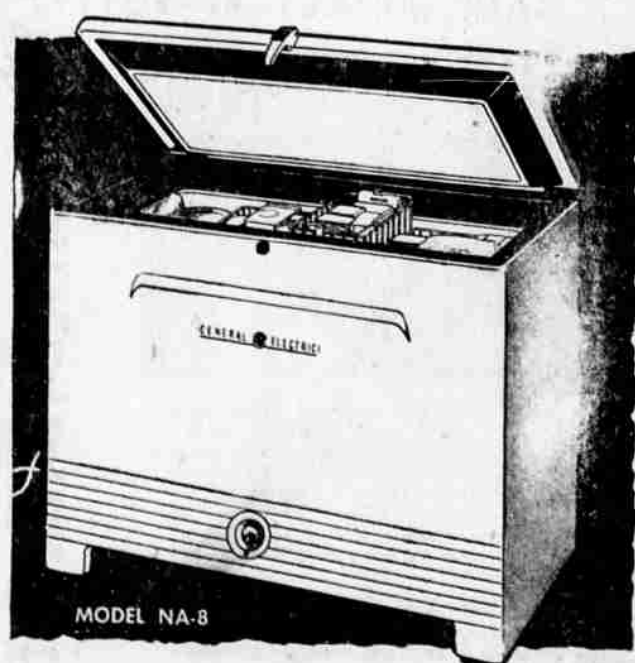
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
