### Senator McCarthy Has Stomach Operation

WASHINGTON (AP) — Senator McCarthy (R-Wisc.) underwent a major stomach operation Thursday which his doctors said would keep him from taking any active part in his campaign for renomination.

A bulletin by Dr. George W. Calver, official physician for members of Congress, said a physical checkup at the hospital "revealed a herniation of stomach through a rupture in the diaphragm."

McCarthy's office aides said later "the Senator came through the operation very well and is doing as well as could be expected. His condition is not critical."

## Bid For Farmer Vote Contained In Demo Plank

CHICAGO (AP) — Democrats were out after the 1952 farm vote Thursday with an offer of a broadened program protecting agricultural prices against declines.

Price supports or floors, now propping the basic crops of corn, wheat, cotton, rice, tobacco and peanuts, would be extended to perishable commodities, such as livestock, dairy and poultry products.

A farm plank adopted by the party's national convention abandoned a flexible price support program — at least through 1954 — endorsed in the Democratic platform four years ago.

Instead it applauded recent action of Congress in boosting supports to a higher level than otherwise might have prevailed during the next two years.

That Congressional action requires the government to support prices of the basic crops at not less than 90 percent of parity until 1955.

Parity is a standard for measuring farm prices, declared by law to be equally fair to farmers and those who buy their products.

The Republican convention two weeks ago adopted a farm plank that promised price supports at "whatever level is necessary" to maintain balanced production.

This has been interpreted by some farm leaders as an endorsement of the flexible system dropped for the time being by the Democrats.

Under the flexible system, price supports could range between 75 and 90 per cent of parity.

President Truman's administration has criticized this system, contending it offers farmers the least protection when they might need it most.

The Republican plank said, however, that it would aim at full-parity farm prices at the marketplace. But it did not say how it would seek to achieve such a goal.

The Democrats did not mention by name a controversial farm plan advanced by Secretary of Agriculture Brannan in 1949. But some of its major objectives were, in effect, endorsed. The Brannan plan called for high, rigid supports and for extension of price aid to perishable crops through use of government subsidies.

The new plank made no mention of subsidies. It merely stated the party would seek "practical methods" for supporting the perishables,

### Navy Recruiter Comes Here Only On Wednesday

Navy recruitment work in Roseburg is being handled one day a week — Wednesday — from 10 a. m. to 3 p. m., DST, in the Court House by Chief Petty Officer Leo Boyd from the Eugene recruiting office.

The regular Roseburg recruitment officer, Chief Petty Officer, Al DeMott, was removed from full time duty here as part of a recent navy expense-cutting program.

He left town this morning but doesn't report to San Francisco until Aug. 5 for the trip over. His family will follow in about three or four months.

### Strike Threat Against Pullman Co. Called Off

CHICAGO (AP) — A threatened strike against the Pullman Company, which had been called for July 29 and would have affected the country's major railroads, was cancelled Thursday.

The Pullman Company and the Order of Railway Conductors, who had called the strike, announced a settlement of their wage dispute and cancellation of the walkout.

The announcement said the conductors had been granted a 12 1/2 cent hourly basic wage increase retroactive to Jan. 1, 1951 plus "the standard railroad cost of living escalator clause and a wage and rules moratorium to Oct. 1, 1953."

### Weekly Earnings Reach All Time High In June

SALEM (AP) — Weekly earnings of Oregon's manufacturing workers rose in June to an all-time high of \$80.80, the Oregon Unemployment Compensation Commission said Thursday.

The average hourly wage was \$2.04, virtually the same as it has been for several months. The average work week jumped from 38.1 hours in May to 39.6 hours in June, accounting for the increase in weekly wages.

Logging and lumber workers got average pay checks of \$92.14 a week in June.

### Train Halts In Time To Save Track Sleeper

HUDSON, N. Y. (AP) — The Engineer of a New York Central passenger train jerked on the air brakes early Thursday at an emergency signal from the control tower here.

A man was lying across the tracks.

Jordan Brown, 41, of Berthelville, Okla., told police: "I just got tired and thought it was time for me to go to sleep."

A railroad worker had spotted Brown and notified the control tower. Brown was held on a trespassing charge.

### 'Skywatch' Heads Quit Over Public Apathy

BEND (AP) — Two leaders of this city's "operation skywatch" have resigned because of public apathy, and the county coordinator said he would also quit unless interest increased.

Evelyn Whiff, supervisor of the Bend observation post, and Mrs. William G. Wilson, chief observer, resigned. Jesse L. Yardley, county coordinator, appealed for more volunteer workers. He said he would resign if they failed to respond.
