

International Harvester Plant Strike Settled

MILWAUKEE (AP)—Eighty employees of the International Harvester Co. parts depot were back on the job Tuesday, ending a 47-day strike for higher wages.

The company signed a three-year contract with the CIO Automobile Workers Union providing for an immediate 4 cent hourly pay boost, annual wage increases of 4 cents an hour, a cost of living wage adjustment clause and merit pay boosts.

Shortage Of Cars Blamed On Quake In California

PORTLAND (AP)—Last week's California earthquake was blamed Tuesday for a shortage of railway freight cars for shipment of Oregon products, particularly lumber.

K. C. Batchelder, traffic manager for the West Coast Lumbermen's Association, said the shortage was critical and that an appeal had been made to the Defense Transportation Administration and the Interstate Commerce Commission for relief.

Batchelder said the quake closed the Southern Pacific Railroad line through the Tehachapi Mountains south of Bakersfield, Calif. As a result traffic has been shifted to the railroad's coast line, causing a jam, Batchelder said.

This has brought about a shortage of box cars for lumber shipments which is expected to reach 50 per cent.

The ICC and DTA has been asked to route more empty cars over northern railroad lines in the emergency, he said. He also planned to meet Tuesday with the Oregon Public Utilities commissioner in Salem.

A Southern Pacific spokesman said it probably would be two weeks before the Tehachapi tunnel, closed by the quake, is repaired.

Hog Quarantine Affects Oregon

SIoux FALLS, S. D. (AP)—The U. S. Department of Agriculture has quarantined hogs in California and parts of 15 other states where a swine disease, vesicular exanthema, has appeared.

Areas of infection were cited in a daily newspaper advertisement which the department carried here Tuesday under the heading, "Notice regarding vesicular exanthema."

The advertisement, signed by Knox T. Richardson, assistant secretary of agriculture, included as quarantined:

State of California: Gila County, Arizona; Marion and Multnomah Counties; Oregon; King and Spokane Counties, Washington, and Laramie County, Wyoming.

The notice said, "regulations have been issued restraining the movement of swine and carcasses, parts and offal of swine from the quarantine area in any state to any other state, territory or the District of Columbia."
