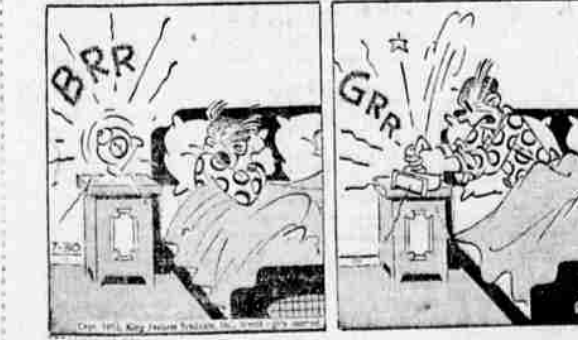

Style Of Dress At Coronation Ball Optional, Director Robinson States; Historical Photographs Requested

Inquiries regarding dress for the Queen's coronation and ball Saturday night at Kennedy's have resulted in the following clarification by Director Horace Robinson: "We are trying to make the ball a memorable event in Roseburg and as a consequence we want to assure all who can will be in proper attire in order not to embarrass themselves or the rest of the guests," Robinson explained. "Women who would like to wear formal dresses may do so, others will be quite at home in Centennial pioneer dress or dressed in their 'Sunday best'... We hope that the dancers to the best of their ability will dress to the dignity of the occasion." Centennial Headquarters today issued a call for historical photographs depicting early Douglas County dating back to the 1880s through the early 1900s. They will be copied for reproduction in the Centennial souvenir program which will contain some 60 pages of pictures of both early and present day Douglas County. Suggested photos include shots of early Roseburg and other communities, early lumber or logging operations, stagecoaches, public buildings and other items. Family photographs or pictures later than the early 1900's are not suitable. Applications are still being accepted at Centennial headquarters.

Killer Of Family Of 4 Faces Charge Of Murder

WATERVILLE, Wash. (AP)—Twenty-seven-year-old Matthias V. Swearson was charged with first degree murder Monday night in connection with the slaying of his wife and four children. He was arrested as he drove to church. Police Chief Lyle Prothro said Swearson admitted the slayings and told officers: "The Lord told me to do and I did." Prothro said Swearson tried three times to take his own life and quoted the carpenter as saying when he failed he "decided to go to church." He was naked to the waist and bleeding from head, throat and chest wounds when taken into custody. TWO YOUTHS ACCUSED: Two Roseburg youths are held in \$2,000 bail in the county jail on charges of sodomy. They are Richard Ardiel Dubell, 20, of 25 Miller Lane, and Galen LaVerne Gingrich, 20, 202 Sweetbriar Ave. Both were granted time Monday in district court to consult an attorney. They were arrested by state and city police. Dubell is also charged with possession of liquor by a minor. Bail was set at \$300 on that charge.

FBI Still Seeks Crater Lake Park Slayer

KLAMATH FALLS (AP)—"Progress by elimination" was the report Tuesday of J. B. Poster, agent in charge of the Portland FBI office, who is directing the investigation of the slaying of two men in Crater Lake National Park. Poster came here to take charge of the investigation in the shootings of C. P. Culhane, Detroit, and A.M. Jones, Concord, Calif. Both were executives of the United Motors Service Corp, a General Motors subsidiary. Missing for two days, they were found shot to death and robbed.
