

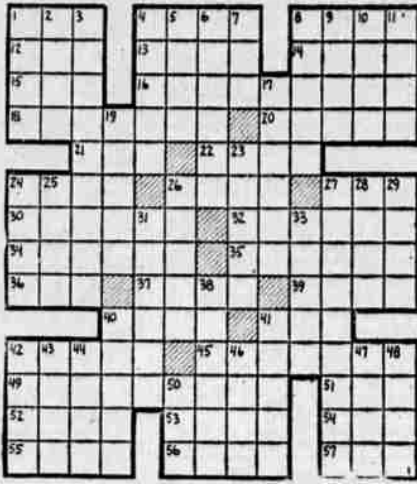

Glendale Farm Bureau Hears Speeches By County Officials

Judge Lin Beckley from the Douglas County Court in Roseburg, Dr. Don Bailey, County Veterinarian, and Roland Parker, County Extension Agent, were featured speakers at a well-attended Farm Bureau meeting held last week at the Lewis Brady home near Astoria.

Judge Beckley spoke briefly and was followed by Parker, who discussed the work of the Milk Production Board, particularly concerning the dairy products measure which will appear on the November ballot.

Dr. Bailey told something of his work as County Veterinarian and dwelt in particular on the cow-testing program under which the owner of even one cow may have his animal tested for both tuberculosis and brucellosis without cost.
