Forestland may yield 400 tons of wood in the form of logs; but only a very small portion, actually less than one per cent, of this weight is made up of nutrients — mainly nitrogen and minerals — according to Youngberg, who is one of the nation's few forest soils specialists.

"Only a relatively small amount of nutrients are removed with the timber," says Youngberg. "During the 80 to 100 years required to produce a timber crop, this depletion is more than replaced by the weathering of minerals in the soil and the addition of nitrogen by rainfall and the action of nitrogen-fixing organisms in the soil."

Revolving Fertility

How do trees produce immense quantities of wood — perhaps 20,000 cubic feet of wood to the acre at harvest time — without depleting the soil?

"Largely through a system of revolving fertility," says Youngberg. "The tree returns the minerals and nutrients to the soil in the form of leaf litter. Time and weather rot the leaf fall to its original ingredients and these are drawn up into the tree again through the roots. The nutrients are used in the production of wood and returned to the earth in the form of leaf litter, thus completing the cycle."

"The wood which is removed from the forest at the time of log harvest is made up largely of water (which may account for as much as half of the wood by weight) and organic compounds. These organic compounds, mainly cellulose, lignin, resins and waxes, are manufactured by the tree from air and water and do not deplete the soil."

"Nitrogen and other mineral elements taken up from the soil are essential to the manufacturing processes carried on by the tree. However, only a very small portion remain in the leaves and are eventually returned to the soil as leaf fall," the soils scientist continued.

Youngberg, who will join the staff of Oregon State college's school of agriculture this fall, was born in Seattle. Raised in San Diego, he received his bachelor's degree in botany at Wheaton college in 1941, his master's degree in forestry at the University of Michigan in 1947 and his doctor's degree in forest soils in 1951 at the University of Wisconsin.
