

Showers Of Rocks Pose Mystery

EVANSVILLE, Ind. (AP) — For seven successive nights, limestone rocks about the size of a fist have rained down from somewhere onto the roof of Lewis Schattin's farmhouse.

The Schattin farm, five miles north of Evansville, is on level ground, and stands in the open. Neighbors and curiosity seekers have stood guard at the house and in surrounding fields, yet the rock-fall continues from an as yet unknown source.

Deputy Sheriff Leonard Denton went out Tuesday night and was just as mystified as the next one.

David M. Bigelow, director of education at the Evansville Public Museum, suggested that limestone layers under incinerators sometimes explode.

Lewis thought that interesting, but he has had no fires on the premises.

The shower of rocks continued for more than three hours Tuesday night.

The crushed coral runway is now ready for air service between Sydney and Johannesburg, South Africa, due to start in September.

SALEM (AP) — Display space at the Oregon State Fair is almost completely sold out. Glen Hoare, in charge of space sales, said this week end. The fair will run eight days starting Aug. 30.

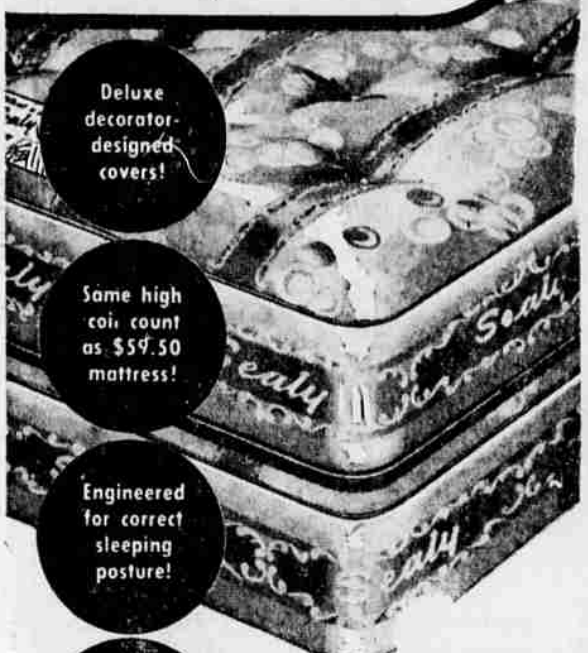

New Master's Degree Wins Student Approval

ASHLAND (AP) — Chancellor Charles D. Byrne told the final session of the two-day State Board of Higher Education meeting Tuesday that its new masters degree program was enthusiastically supported by students.

Enrollment at the state's three colleges of education this summer totalled 215 graduate students, he said. That is almost double the number expected.

The three colleges were authorized last January by the board of education, Oregon State College and the University of Oregon opposed the plan.
