Channel Try Fizzles For US Swimmer

FOLKESTONE, England — Nine swimmers from three countries churned the English Channel today in this season's first attempt at the difficult 21-mile crossing, but the only American to try gave up last night in sight of his goal.

Bob Paysour, a lanky 24-year-old fireman from Gastonia, N. C., was dragged from the calm but cold water about six miles short of the English coast 12 hours and 15 minutes after he plunged in at Cap Gris Nez on the French coast. His trainers said his left leg had become paralyzed as the result of a two-month-old injury.

He was pulled into an accompanying rowboat and then whisked ashore in a motor launch. Supported by two friends and wearing blue sweat clothes over his grease-smeared body, Paysour limped despondently into a Folkestone hotel which had been his training headquarters.

"I could have made it," he said, "but my left leg became paralyzed from my knee down and every time I took a stroke it almost killed me."

"I don't know if I shall make another try at swimming the channel," Paysour said. "Right now I'm more worried about this leg and whether I will be able to do any more swimming with it..."

Six Egyptian swimmers plunged into the channel on the French side early this morning in what looked like a mass assault on the waters dividing France and England.

Miss Jenny James of South Wales, who started from England to France last night, gave up after five hours because of seasickness.

A Danish school mistress, Elna Anderson, who dived in about 30 minutes after Miss James, was still going strong after midnight.

US Approaches Americas Cup Golfing Honor

SEATTLE — The United States had a fingernail grip on the brand new Americas Cup Friday and was banking on the steady play of its champion-studded team to pull it through the second and final day of action against the team of Canadian and Mexican golf.

Harvie Ward of Tarboro, N.C., teamed with Ken Venturi of San Francisco and Sam Urzetta of East Rochester, N.J., with Joe Gagliardi of Larchmont, N.J., to stack up four points Thursday. Canada collected three points and Mexico two as a pair from each nation opposed two others in three "sixome" matches.

Each duo played a single ball, alternating on shots. Friday the teams were matched in singles, each man playing two others over the 36-hole route on the Seattle Golf Club's 6,632 up and down yards.

For a time Thursday it looked like the host nation was on the way to a clean sweep. Ward and Venturi went only 26 holes before they closed out both their opposing pairs. Urzetta and Gagliardi brought home another two points after 32 holes of play.
