## Population Of Congo Increasing Rapidly

LEOPOLDVILLE, Belgian Congo (AP) — The Belgian Congo's tremendous economic boom in the last few years has pumped more than 8,000 whites into the colony. The most unhealthy and remote provinces have proved to be the fastest-growing areas.

In the year 1951 the white population of the Congo has increased by 14 per cent from 57,930 to 66,078. This compares with a native population of about 12 million. There are now 1,948 Americans in the Congo.
