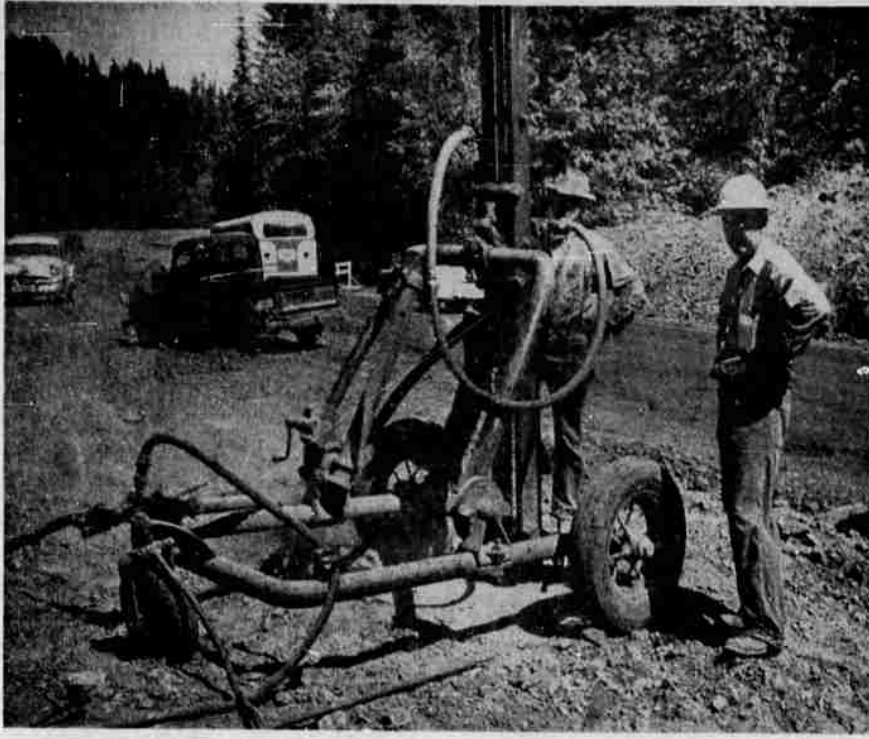

Civil Service Hears Appeals On Dismissals

SALEM — The State Civil Service Commission heard an appeal for reinstatement Wednesday from Ernest F. Kelly, discharged Aug. 1 and an appraiser with the State Veterans Affairs office.

Kelly, who had worked for the office since April, 1948, had been released for "inability to work with fellow employees." Kelly charged the dismissal was the result of inter-office politics.

The commission dismissed an appeal from Neal Buxton, Pendleton, who had requested a hearing after being discharged from his job as hospital aide at the Eastern Oregon State Hospital. Buxton was not present for the hearing.

 Mrs. Sebra Howard spent the past weekend in Portland on a combined business and pleasure trip.

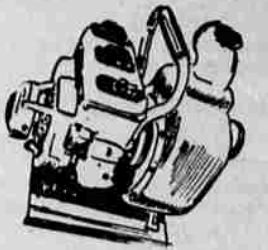
The Cottage Prayer Meeting held by the Glendale Baptist Church will be at the Weatherall home next week.
