

Stater All-Stars Win Shrine, 12-6

PORTLAND — Hard-running Dick Pavlat and an alert State All-Star team rammed to a 12-6 victory over the Portland All-Stars in the annual Shrine benefit football game here Saturday night.

That gave State a 3-2 edge in the annual series between the standout high school seniors from Portland and from upstate.

A crowd of 20,000 saw Pavlat, the Astoria halfback who was named the most valuable player in the game, pound out repeated gains and set up both State touchdowns.

The first came the first time State got its hands on the ball. A 17-yard run by Pavlat was the key play in a 50-yard march to the score. Fullback Larry Rose of Reedsport swept around end 18 yards for the touchdown.

The Portlanders countered at once, moving 66 yards in 12 plays. Halfback Kenny Deane plowed over from four yards out.

Pavlat set up the winning score at the outset of the second half. He returned the kickoff 38 yards. State then marched 31 yards to a touchdown with Pavlat accounting for 20 of the yards in three plays. Quarterback Jerry Crimmins went the final yard.

State then concentrated on turn-

ing back Portland thrusts. The defenders did it well, allowing the feared passer, Jack Keller of Portland to complete only one toss.

In addition to Pavlat's award as most valuable player, there were these awards: Lou Lofland, Portland, best offensive back; Jerry Exley, Portland, best defensive back; Ron Van Metre, The Dalles, best offensive lineman; Jim Boulter, Rogue River, best defensive lineman.

PORTLAND — Eight teams have filed entry for the National Women's Softball Tournament to be held here the week starting Aug. 31. Two of the entries are Canadian teams.

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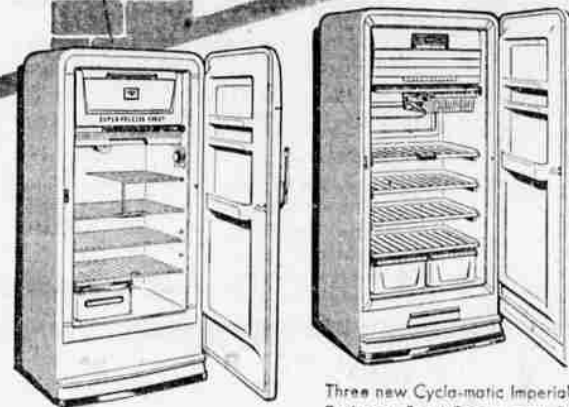
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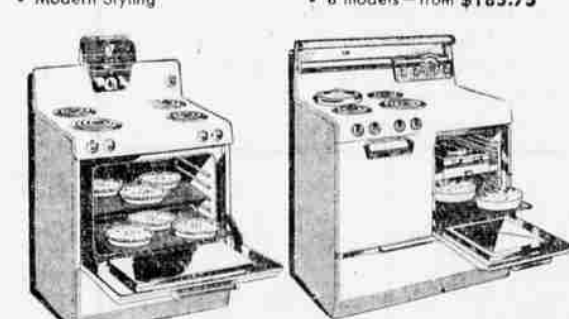
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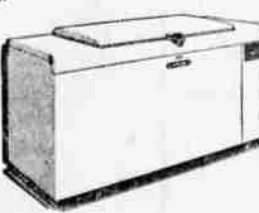
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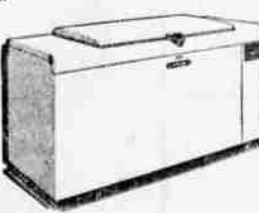
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
