

Stevenson Sees 'Me-Too' Attitude On Part Of Ike

MINOCUA, Wis. — Gov. Adlai Stevenson said Thursday that GOP presidential nominee Dwight D. Eisenhower appeared to be a "me-too" candidate who approves most of the Democratic legislation of the past 20 years.

Stevenson told reporters he saw in Eisenhower's Boise, Ida., speech of Wednesday night general approval of most of the Democratic legislative program since 1932.

The governor made these comments to reporters at the woodland retreat where he is resting and working on drafts of campaign speeches.

Stevenson said his plans for campaigning in the west next month call for stops in both Wyoming and Montana as well as the Pacific Northwest, California and the Southwest. But he gave no de-

tails or the points where he would speak.

Referring to Eisenhower's statement that he was a middle-of-the-road candidate, Stevenson said: "I have always thought that I have been something of a moderate."

Attacks 'Obsolete'

Stevenson brought to the news conference a newspaper clipping of the Eisenhower speech, and then he read a statement he had written hastily as his reply. He said:

"I am glad that the general disapproves of unnecessary expansion of services directly performed by the federal government. I have been preaching and writing about that for a long time."

"His attacks on health insurance and the so-called Brannan plan are interesting but obsolete. Neither is in the Democratic platform

or recommended by the Democratic candidates.

"But I am personally very much concerned with ways and means of meeting the appalling cost to the average family of serious or catastrophic illness."

Middle of Road Liked

"I am sorry the general evidently disapproves of the conservation of our great natural resources and the public power development that has meant so much to the west. If he does not disapprove, then I don't know what his words about the west mean."

"I like the middle of the road between the extremes, too. Most everyone does."

Then Stevenson said that a "middle of the road course" means different things to different people, and that in Sweden such a term means socialism.

'Scottsboro Boy' Dies In Prison Of Cancer

Jackson, Mich. — The death in prison of Heywood Patterson, one of the South's famed "Scottsboro Boys" was announced by Southern Michigan prison authorities Monday.

The 39-year-old Patterson died Friday night of cancer, authorities said. He was serving a six to 15 year term for manslaughter.

The Georgia-born negro, whose book "Scottsboro Boy" gained him a new measure of fame in 1949, has been in Michigan since he fled prison in Alabama in 1948.

There he was serving a 75-year sentence growing out of the "Scottsboro" case of 1931, in which nine Negroes were convicted of raping two white women in a freight car.
