

Miners Grumble Over Holiday

PITTSBURGH (AP) — John L. Lewis' memorial holiday idled his nearly 400,000 coal miners across the nation Monday.

Some grumbling was reported over the United Mine Workers' chief ordering the 10-day holiday to call attention to the safety conditions of the mines.

Said a miner in a western Pennsylvania section where steel companies operate pits:

"The miners are not saying much. Rumors—just rumors—are that they might not go back. I think if it is up to the men they will go back. They don't think too much of the holiday. They want to work due to idleness during the steel strike."

(The miners' union headquarters at Renton, Wash., said coal production had stopped in all Washington State mines, with about 1,250 mine workers idle. A union leader said only repair and maintenance men were on the job in Washington mines).

Trainmen's Brotherhood Endorses Stevenson

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Brotherhood of Railroad Trainmen endorsed the Democratic ticket of Gov. Adlai Stevenson and Sen. John Sparkman Saturday.

W. P. Kennedy, president of the union, released a telegram sent to the Democratic nominees for president and vice-president which said the action carries out the unanimous recommendation of the union's legislative representatives.

McCormick's 3rd Party Call Finds No Favor

Col. Robert R. McCormick, a lifelong Republican, who has repudiated his party and its presidential nominee, and has called for the organization of a new political party, received general negative reaction, even from Republican congressmen he does endorse.

One Republican senator — not on the Chicago Tribune publisher's favored list — used the word "screwball" in commenting on McCormick's radio speech Saturday.

But a Democrat, Sen. Pat McCarran of Nevada, said conservative Republicans and Democrats may form a third party if Gov. Adlai Stevenson and Gen. Dwight D. Eisenhower fail to affirm a policy of "strong Americanism."

Referring to Eisenhower, the Republican candidate, and Stevenson, the Democratic nominee, McCormick said:

"Do not vote for either. . . . Concentrate on voting for patriotic candidates for Congress in both parties."

One Republican Senator whom McCormick endorsed as a man "every patriot should vote for" said he was complimented.

Four other McCormick-endorsed congressmen said they supported the Republican party "down the line" and a fourth disavowed the publisher's proposal that an "American party" be formed.

Two refused to comment and the rest were not reached immediately.

Sen. Harry Cain of Washington endorsed by the publisher, commented:

"The only ambition I have. . . . Is to act and be known as an American patriot. I am complimented by Colonel McCormick's faith in my intentions."
