San Diego Takes West Jr. Title

DENVER (AP) — Boy teams from Austin, Tex., Cincinnati and San Diego, Calif., Thursday night fought their way into the American Legion's junior world series of baseball opening in Denver Monday.

Those three clubs join with Milford, Mass., in making up the four national finalists — the best of more than 16,000 teams.

The competition is for boys who were not yet 17 last Jan. 1, that played American Legion junior baseball this season.

San Diego copped the Western sectional title Thursday night, eliminating Denver 5-4 in 11 innings. Salem, Ore., the Pacific Northwest regional titlist, was eliminated earlier in the tournament at Hastings, Neb.

Mathias To Skip Track Trip For Grid Practice

PALO ALTO, Calif. (AP) — Stanford's 1952 football hopes took an upward turn Friday with the disclosure that first string fullback Bob Mathias will skip a track and field trip to Japan to report for football practice.

The 21-year-old Olympic decathlon champion told Coach Buck Taylor he'll report. He asked and got permission to show up Sept. 8, a week late.

Mathias, about 10 pounds under his football weight of 205, will take a week's rest at Kings Canyon National Park.

Mrs. Pung defeated Edean Anderson of Helena, Mont., 2 up; Miss Lesser won from the California champion, Barbara Romack of Sacramento, 3 and 2; Miss Garner ousted 17-year-old Barbara Snook of Portland, 2 and one, and Miss McFedders, who had never even seen a National before, much less played in one, defeated Claire Doran of Cleveland, last year's runner-up, on the 20th hole.

Saturday the winners meet at 36 holes for the title won in 1951 by Dorothy Kirby. Two days ago Dorothy lost to Miss Anderson.
