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Roseburg Potato Dealers Face Federal Charges

PORTLAND (AP) — Two Roseburg potato dealers were charged Thursday with violating price ceilings. An OPS complaint in Federal Court accused Donald A. Matsen and Donald C. Bliss of selling seed potatoes in May for nearly \$715 more than ceiling prices. The men operate the firm of Matsen & Bliss. The government seeks triple damages.
