Adult Education Classes Not Yet Filled In City

There are still some openings in Roseburg Public Schools' adult education classes, Jack Brooks, director, announced today. Classes are held in the Senior High school facilities. Registrations will be taken between 6:30 and 9:30 any evening this week, in the Fullerton building on the campus.

There are still openings in typing classes, which meet on Monday and Wednesday evenings, and in shorthand and bookkeeping, which meet on Tuesday and Thursday evenings. If enough people wish to have advanced bookkeeping or typing classes they may be set up, Brooks said.

The ceramics class, which meets Wednesday evenings, is full but if enough people want it another class may be set up. To date there have been no registrations in the Tuesday sketching class.

Registrations will also be accepted for the following shop classes: art metal and wood turning on Monday, fly tying on Tuesday, and woodworking and cabinetmaking on Wednesday.

Two dressmaking classes are also being offered, one each for beginners and advanced groups; the first meets on Tuesday and the advanced class on Thursday. The interior decoration class must have a few more people enrolled before it can be operated.

The public speaking class, which meets on Tuesday, and the Thursday class in modern poetic techniques and marketing will also need more persons before they can be held. Most classes must have at least 12 persons enrolled.

A beginners class in international folk dancing, offered in cooperation with the Roseburg International Folk Dancers, will meet on Wednesday nights. This class must have a minimum enrollment of 24 but will take up to 36 people.

A 10-week class in "Food Service" will meet on Tuesday nights.
