

Acheson Query Raised By Nixon

LOS ANGELES (AP) — Sen. Richard M. Nixon swung into a day of campaigning in his home county Friday after calling upon Gov. Adlai Stevenson to say whether he would retain Dean Acheson as secretary of state if elected president.

The Republican vice presidential candidate also charged that his wife and family had been included in a campaign "of character assassination in the worst low-kick Truman tradition."

Nixon said in a statement that he was recently told that President Truman informed a group on his last visit to California "that an all-out personal attack would be launched against me during the last week of the campaign."

"The strategy was to have a new false charge issued each day so that the truth could never catch up with the falsehood," he added. "It is obvious that this scheme is under way."

Beauty Quits Movie Try To Aid Accused Mother

Westbrook Case Under Tight Investigation

WASHINGTON (AP) — A "top-to-bottom" investigation was underway today into a government deal to buy nine million dollars of tungsten, already the center of a political storm causing rough words on both sides of the Atlantic.

Defense Materials Administrator Jess Larson—who signed the contract and then canceled it as chief buyer of critical goods for the government—said he is heading the investigation.

Larsen said one thing he wants cleared up is why he was not given an unsigned letter-contract which disclosed that the tungsten deal involved a 5 per cent fee to three men.

One of the three, Col. Lawrence Westbrook, was fired Wednesday night as a Democratic National Committee official.

Westbrook told the Herald Tribune from Dallas he had done nothing wrong. He blamed the contract cancellation on an international

group which he said wanted to sell strategic materials to the United States at a higher price than his client, a Portuguese firm called Companhia Atlantica.

Gen Dwight D. Eisenhower, the Republican candidate for president, said in a speech in New York City yesterday that the case is the "sort of crookedness that goes on and on in Washington."

"They had to fire him because someone caught up with him," Eisenhower said of Westbrook.

BECAUSE We believe that Communist infiltration of government and certain other organizations is a clear and present danger . . . and not a "red herring," as Truman has stubbornly insisted.

We believe Republican effort to smoke out these Communists is not a "pursuit of phantoms," as Stevenson has called it.

We believe that Alger Hiss might still be an influential "Fair Deal" advisor, but for the courageous work of Senator Nixon. The national administration not only has failed to lead the fight against Communist infiltration in government—but has actually obstructed those who have tried to oust the Communists.

BECAUSE The reckless and spendthrift policies of the present administration has resulted in:

The largest Federal bureaucracy, and the largest Federal payroll in history.

Taxes reaching an all-time high.

A staggering Federal debt of 260 billion dollars.

A shrinkage in the value of the dollar to 52 cents.

The depreciation, by fifty per cent, of the value of savings, life insurance, pensions and the like.

The worst inflation and the highest cost of living in our history.

BECAUSE A married couple with two children whose earnings in 1939 were \$333.00 a month must now earn \$750.00 a month just to stay even!

BECAUSE In 18 of the past 20 years the federal administration has lived beyond its income and gone each year deeper into debt. Even during the most productive years in the history of our country this government did not put aside or save anything for leaner years, or to reduce its colossal debt.

And this year, even while taking from the American people the greatest taxes ever collected by any government on the face of the earth, this Federal government will spend TEN BILLION DOLLARS MORE THAN IT TAKES IN!

BECAUSE Governor Stevenson has accepted the leadership of the left-wing politicians and the big city "bosses" who have spawned and bred and nourished the corruption, the extravagances, the abuses and the misguided socialism against which we are in rebellion.

If elected, he could not repudiate the people who picked and elected him. That he would not is clear from his own words when after nomination he addressed the National Democratic Convention in Chicago, saying: "I accept your program!"

BECAUSE Stevenson, in his campaign to date, has repeatedly approved the Democratic platform to toto. He has likewise endorsed the major policies of "Trumanism" as follows: Stevenson favors further increase in "Big Government" at the expense of the States (e.g., his desire to seize the off-shore oil lands).

Stevenson, as his Baltimore speech indicates, apparently approves the Truman fiscal policies which have produced our shocking inflation, ruinous debt, and the highest taxes in history.

Stevenson likewise approves the entire Truman foreign policy—a policy which has led America into the Korean war.

Stevenson has not repudiated the alien Truman philosophy of

"unlimited inherent powers" in the Executive Branch of the Government.

Stevenson's record in Illinois, where (according to a survey of Illinois newspaper editors conducted by U.S. News and World Report) he converted a substantial surplus into a deficit, indicates that he would continue the reckless extravagance and waste of the Truman regime.

Stevenson makes only one criticism of the Truman administration.

He admits the "mess in Washington," but thinks he should be given a chance to clean it up!
